EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: In 2011, HB 277 was enacted, providing a framework for deer hunters

in this state practicing supplemental feeding; and

WHEREAS: Since 2011, the Department of Natural Resources has found no

evidence that hunting over feed has directly impacted deer harvest numbers, nor has the Department observed any direct evidence of

disease linked to supplemental feeding in Georgia; and

WHEREAS: Pursuant to O.C.G.A. §§ 27-3-9 and 27-3-15, the Board of Natural

Resources is authorized to establish Northern and Southern deer hunting zones based on sound wildlife management principles; and

WHEREAS: In the Southern Zone of the state hunters may hunt deer within two

hundred yards of feed, while those in the Northern Zone may not;

and

WHEREAS: Such a distinction produces an inequity among licensed hunters

based on geography which is not necessarily tied to deer population

and abundance

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS

GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

Ordered: That the Department of Natural Resources evaluate and determine

an appropriate expansion of the Southern Zone and present such findings to the Board for action based on sound wildlife management

principles.
