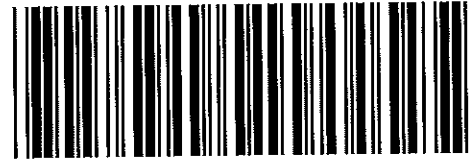

PROBABLE CAUSE COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION TO COUNCIL

CASE NO. 003-314-12-15

1. SJ is multi-certified (Corrections Officer, Basic Law Enforcement, Arson Investigator, and General Instructor).
2. Officer SJ was employed with the most recent law enforcement unit from 01/19/2007 until he was terminated on 11/24/2015.
3. Officer SJ is not currently employed by a law enforcement unit.
4. Officer SJ was suspended for a training deficiency under 464-5-20.
5. Officer SJ self-reported his 05/12/2016 arrest.
6. Officer SJ did not submit a response to this investigation.
7. Officer SJ was the subject of a previous POST investigation. (See Attachment A)

CASE SUMMARY

On 10/05/2015, Officer SJ was simultaneously employed by two different law enforcement units. Investigations were initiated into Officer SJ's reporting of his duty time and failure to report for duty.

On 07/30/2015, Officer SJ's physician cleared him for work on "modified duty with restrictions." Despite that, Officer SJ failed to report for duty on 08/02/2015. He continued to be absent from work until 10/02/2015. These absences were unauthorized. During the time that Officer SJ failed to report for duty due to claimed medical issues, he was reporting for duty at his other agency. While on duty with that agency, he worked without restriction or modified duty.

An investigation by Officer SJ's other agency found discrepancies in the time Officer SJ reported on his timesheet and the time he worked. Officer SJ claimed to have worked eighty-nine shifts (588 hours) when he did not. He received payment for the time worked in the amount of \$8,526. This occurred during the years of 2014 and 2015. On some of the dates that Officer SJ reported to be working at this agency, he was actually on-duty at the other agency.

POST records indicate that Officer SJ voluntarily resigned from the agency where he failed to report for duty. Documentation received from the agency indicates he was terminated on or around 11/04/2015 for violating policies related to failing to report for duty.

On 11/24/2015, Officer SJ was terminated from the agency where he reported time that he did not work, for violating policies related to ethics and code of conduct.

On 05/12/2016, Officer SJ was arrested on a Grand Jury Arrest Warrant. He was charged with Felony – Theft by Taking. Officer SJ was ultimately indicted for thirty-six counts of Felony – Theft by Taking.

On 05/05/2017, after successfully completing pre-trial diversion Officer SJ's case was placed on the Dead Docket.

CASE SUMMARY

This person is certified (Corrections 06-09-95) and is a candidate for Peace Officer certification. He/she was hired by a fire department on or about 11-02-98 and is currently assigned to the position of fire investigator. In order for the officer to make arrests related to arson investigations, the officer's position was transferred to the same municipality's law enforcement agency on 12-19-05 prompting his/her application for Peace Officer certification. The officer reported an arrest dated 11-17-97 for Theft by Conversion on his/her P.O.S.T. application. The officer previously failed to report this arrest to P.O.S.T. The officer was not employed in a law enforcement position at the time of his/her arrest.

The officer was arrested on a warrant dated 02-04-97 for Theft by Conversion (misdemeanor) which alleged the officer had rented three video movies, valued at \$200.00, and failed to return the movies to the store. In a written statement, the officer said the tape was inadvertently returned late because he/she had moved from the area. The video store had already obtained a warrant for the officer and closed after the tape was returned but did not dismiss the warrant. According to the court document, the warrant was nolle prossed on 03-12-98 after the store failed to respond to the court.

The officer is currently employed in law enforcement.
