On July 27, 2019 at approximately 2016 hours I, Corporal Juarez, responded to Lester Fordham road near Williams road in reference to a driving complainant. Upon arrival the complainant stated that she was traveling on Williams road when a dark colored Duramax pulling a trailer pulled in front of her, nearly causing a motor vehicle accident. The complainant pressed the horn to get the other driver's attention, and he then proceeded to pull off the roadway.

As he pulled off the roadway, he then signaled his middle finger at her. An occupant of the complainant's vehicle noticed, and he then signaled his middle finger in return to the driver of the Duramax. The complainant proceed to drive around the Duramax, and as she gained distance from the Offender, she heard multiple loud "pop" sounds. The complainant described these sounds as a firearm being discharged.

At that time, the complainant was able to provide me a location of where the offender may have resided. I then arrived at that residence which the complainant described, and I met with the offender's brother. The Offender's brother provided me information on how to reach the offender, and I was only able to reach the offender by phone. According to the offender, there were no conflicting statements in the matter, however, the offender advised there was not firearm involved in the incident. The offender admitted to directing his middle finger at the complainant, but he advised he didn't discharge a firearm.

After further investigation, I returned to the area of where the incident occurred. I searched the area for shell casings for a firearm discharge, but none were

located. Due to no evidence of the discharge of a firearm, the report was documented for disorderly conduct. Nothing Further.
