INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

ON THE ABOVE DATE AND TIME, WE RESPONDED TO A CALL IN REFERENCE TO A DOMESTIC DISPUTE. THE CALLER STATED THAT HER DAD WHO DOES NOT LIVE THERE SHOWED UP TO THE RESIDENCE OF HER AND HER MOTHER AND BEGAN TO MAKE THREATS TO THEM. SHE STATED THAT HE WANTED TO TALK AND WAS KNOCKING ON THE DOOR BUT THEY DID NOT LET HIM IN. THE COMPLAINANT STATED THAT SHE FEARED HE WOULD TRY TO DO SOMETHING TO THEM SO SHE GRABBED HER FIREARM IN PREPARATION.

WHILE ON SCENE, THE COMPLAINANT STATED THAT SHE BELIEVED THE OFFENDER WAS WALKING ON THE DIRT ROAD BEHIND THEIR HOUSE. WE WERE ABLE TO LOCATE HIM AND ATTEMPTED TO CALL HIM OVER BUT HE APPEARED TO IGNORE US. WHILE DOING SO, THE COMPLAINANT WAS ACTING VERY FRANTIC AND STATED THAT HE HAD A GUN MULTIPLE TIMES. NOT KNOWING WHAT HIS INTENTIONS WERE WE DECIDED NOT TO FURTHER ATTEMPT TO APPROACH HIM. AT THIS TIME, THE OFFENDER LEFT THE SCENE IN HIS VEHICLE.

THE OFFENDER THEN CALLED THE COMPLAINANT ON THE PHONE. WE WERE ABLE TO SPEAK WITH HIM OVER THE PHONE SO THAT WE COULD MEET WITH HIM AND TALK TO HIM. HE AGREED TO MEET US AT THE GAS STATION AT 301 SOUTH AND THE BYPASS (CIRCLE K). BEFORE I LEFT I BEGAN TO SPEAK WITH THE COMPLAINANT ONCE MORE NOW THAT SHE HAD CALMED DOWN. I ASKED IF THE OFFENDER HAD ANY BUSINESS BEING AT HER RESIDENCE AND SHE STATED THAT HE DID NOT. I THEN ASKED IF SHE WOULD LIKE HIM SERVED WITH CRIMINAL TRESPASS AND SHE STATED SHE DID.

WE WERE THEN ABLE TO MAKE CONTACT WITH THE OFFENDER AT CIRCLE K. THE OFFENDER STATED HE WENT OVER TO HIS DAUGHTER AND EX WIFE'S RESIDENCE TO TALK ABOUT SOME THINGS THAT HAPPENED WHILE HE WAS IN PRISON. HE STATED THAT THE COMPLAINANT NO LONGER WANTED TO TALK AND TOLD HIM TO COME BACK TOMORROW MORNING. I THEN ADVISED THE OFFENDER OF THE CRIMINAL TRESPASS WARNING PROCESS AND SERVED HIM ON SCENE. HE STATED HE UNDERSTOOD. REPORT FOR DOCUMENTATION.

THE VICTIM STATED THAT HE RECENTLY RECEIVED AN EMAIL FROM ROCKAUTO.COM CONFIRMING A ORDER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$283.48. THE VICTIM STATED THAT AFTER FURTHER INVESTIGATION IT WAS FOUND THAT AN UNKNOWN OFFENDER HACKED INTO HIS ROCKAUTO ACCOUNT, MADE THIS PURCHASE AND ADDED THREE ADDRESSES TO THE ACCOUNT. THE ADDRESSES ARE AS FOLLOWS 114 CLUB DR STOCKBRIDGE, GA 30261 (THIS WAS THE SHIPPING ADDRESS), 2287 PEMBERTON RD SW ATLANTA, GA 30331 AND PO BOX 405 BYHALIA, MS 38611. A PHONE NUMBER OF (404) 437-4767 WAS ALSO ATTACHED TO THE ORDER. I ATTEMPTED TO MAKE CONTACT WITH SOMEONE AT THAT PHONE NUMBER BUT NO ONE ANSWERED. A VOICEMAIL WAS LEFT.

THE ORDER CONFIRMATION STATES THAT THE BALANCE WAS PAID VIA A VISA CARD. AT THIS TIME NO MONIES HAVE BEEN TAKEN FROM THE VICTIM'S ACCOUNT. IT IS UNKNOWN IF THE VICTIM'S PAYMENT INFORMATION WAS USED OR IF SOME OTHER TYPE OF PAYMENT WAS USED FOR THE PURCHASE

VICTIM HAS CONTACTED HIS BANKING INSTITUTION AND TAKEN MEASURES TO SECURE HIS ROCKAUTO ACCOUNT. COPIES OF THE ORDER CONFIRMATION AND SAVED ADDRESSES ON THE ACCOUNT HAVE BEEN ADDED TO THE LINKED FILES TAB OF THIS REPORT. CASE STILL UNDER INVESTIGATION.
