INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

ON 04/03/2020, I DEPUTY SHAFER WAS DISPATCHED TO HANDLE A CALL VIA PHONE ABOUT A HARASSING COMMUNICATIONS INCIDENT THAT OCCURRED AT 3999 BEN GRADY COLLINS ROAD. I CONTACTED MR. SAMUEL PLOTTS WHO WAS THE COMPLAINANT. MR. PLOTTS ADVISED ME THAT MR. TOMMY DYE SENT HIM A FACE BOOK MESSAGE ASKING IF MR. PLOTTS THREATENED MR. DYE'S SON WITH A GUN AS WELL AS THREATENED TO PUNCH HIS SON'S GRANDMOTHER.

MR. PLOTTS RESPONDED TO THE MESSAGE " I GUESS I AM WHAT YOU GONNA DO?" MR. PLOTTS ADVISED THAT MR. DYE REPLIED " I GUESS YOU'LL SEE."

MR. PLOTTS ADVISED THAT HE FELT THREATENED BY THE MESSAGES THAT WERE SENT TO HIM AND WANTED A REPORT MADE. I ADVISED MR. PLOTTS A REPORT WOULD BE MADE, AND ASKED MR. PLOTTS TO SEND ME A SCREEN SHOT OF THE MESSAGES FOR THE REPORT. REPORT FOR DOCUMENTATION.

INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

ON THE ABOVE TIME AND DATE, I SPOKE WITH THE COMPLAINANT VIA PHONE IN REFERENCE TO AN ISSUE WITH HER HUSBAND WHO DOES NOT LIVE WITH HER. THE COMPLAINANT ADVISED THAT HER HUSBAND COMES TO HER RESIDENCE TO SEE THEIR DAUGHTER THAT THEY HAVE TOGETHER. SHE STATED THAT TODAY WHEN HE ARRIVED HE WAS ABLE TO SEE THEIR DAUGHTER BUT SHE ATTEMPTED TO TALK TO HIM IN REFERENCE TO THEM GETTING A DIVORCE. SHE STATED THAT WHEN SHE TOLD HIM THIS, HE BECAME UPSET AND BEGAN TO YELL AT HER AND HE SLAPPED THE DIVORCE PAPERS OUT OF HER HANDS.

THE COMPLAINANT ADVISED THAT AT THIS TIME, THE OFFENDER GRABBED THEIR DAUGHTER AND WAS ABOUT TO ATTEMPT TO LEAVE. SHE STATED THAT SHE TOLD HIM SHE WAS GOING TO CALL 911 IF HE TOOK HER. AT THIS TIME, HE GAVE THE CHILD BACK TO HER AND LEFT SHORTLY AFTER.

ALSO, THE COMPLAINANT ADVISED ME THAT SHE WANTED THE OFFENDER SERVED WITH CRIMINAL TRESPASS SINCE HE DID NOT LIVE THERE AND ALSO SHE DID NOT WANT HIM THERE BECAUSE SHE FEARED FOR HER SAFETY WHEN HE WAS AROUND. I WAS ABLE TO MAKE CONTACT WITH THE OFFENDER VIA PHONE AND SERVE HIM WITH A CRIMINAL TRESPASS WARNING WHERE HE STATED HE UNDERSTOOD.

THE COMPLAINANT ADVISED ME THAT SHE WANTED INFORMATION ON GETTING A RESTRAINING ORDER AGAINST THE OFFENDER. I WAS ABLE TO ADVISE HER ON THE STEPS SHE NEEDS TO TAKE TO DO SO AND ALSO TO DIVORCE THE OFFENDER AND GO TO COURT TO OBTAIN CUSTODY OF THEIR CHILD. I ALSO WAS ABLE TO GIVE THE COMPLAINANT INFORMATION ABOUT SAFE HAVEN AS WELL. REPORT FOR DOCUMENTATION.

INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

ON THE ABOVE DATE AND TIME, I RESPONDED TO A CALL IN REFERENCE TO AN ALTERCATION. UPON MY ARRIVAL, THE COMPLAINANT ADVISED ME THAT HIS FRIEND WHO HAS BEEN STAYING ON THE PROPERTY IN A CAMPER AND HIS DAUGHTER WHO ALSO LIVES ON THE PROPERTY IN A SEPARATE CAMPER RECENTLY GOTTEN INTO AN ALTERCATION. HE STATED THE ARGUMENT STEMMED OVER THE OFFENDER HAVING HER MUSIC UP TO LOUD. HE STATED THE VICTIM ASKED HER TO TURN IT DOWN. THE COMPLAINANT ADVISED THAT HE GAVE THE VICTIM PERMISSION TO TURN THE POWER OFF TO THE OFFENDER'S CAMPER DUE TO IT BEING OWNED BY HIM, WHERE HE SUBSEQUENTLY DID AFTER ASKING HER TO TURN IT DOWN ONCE MORE. THE COMPLAINANT THEN STATED THE OFFENDER WENT AND TURNED OFF THE VICTIM'S POWER AND THAT IS WHEN THE ALTERCATION STARTED.

THE VICTIM WAS ABLE TO CORROBORATE THE STORY THE COMPLAINANT GAVE. HE STATED THAT HE ATTEMPTED TO GET HER TO TURN THE MUSIC DOWN BUT SHE BECAME ARGUMENTATIVE AND SOON AFTER TURNED HIS POWER OFF. WHILE THE VICTIM WENT TO CONFRONT THE OFFENDER, HE STATED SHE BECAME COMBATIVE WITH HIM AT THIS TIME. HE STATED SHE STARTED TO PUNCH HIM IN THE FACE SEVERAL TIMES. WHILE SHE CONTINUED TO STRIKE HIM, HE STATED IN AN ATTEMPT TO RESTRAIN HER HE ATTEMPTED TO TAKE HER TO THE GROUND. WHEN HE WAS ABLE TO GET HER DOWN, HE WAS ABLE TO SUBDUE HER WITH A FULL NELSON HOLD UNTIL SOMEONE WAS ABLE TO CALM HER DOWN.

I THEN WAS ABLE TO SPEAK WITH THE OFFENDER. WHILE ATTEMPTING TO TALK WITH THE OFFENDER, SHE APPEARED TO BE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF SOME SUBSTANCE. SHE WAS NOT COOPERATIVE AND WOULD NOT GIVE HER SIDE OF THE STORY. SHE STATED SHE DID NOT KNOW WHY WE WERE HERE.

WHILE SPEAKING WITH THE VICTIM, HE DID IN FACT HAVE MARKS ON HIS FACE FROM THE ALTERCATION. HE ADVISED THAT HE WANTED TO PLACE CHARGES ON THE OFFENDER. AT THIS TIME, THERE WAS ENOUGH PROBABLE CAUSE TO EFFECT AN ARREST OF THE OFFENDER BUT DUE TO THE GLOBAL COVID-19 PANDEMIC, THE BULLOCH COUNTY JAIL WOULD NOT ACCEPT THE OFFENDER DUE TO IT NOT BEING A FAMILY VIOLENCE CHARGE OR VIOLENT FELONY. I ADVISED THE COMPLAINANT AND VICTIM OF THIS SITUATION AND ADVISED THAT IF THEY WANTED TO MAKE THEIR OWN CHARGES THEY COULD OBTAIN A WARRANT THROUGH THE MAGISTRATE COURT. REPORT FOR DOCUMENTATION.

INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

ON 4/5/2020, I RESPONDED TO THE AREA OF 2080 MCELVEEN POND RD IN REFERENCE TO THE CALLER ADVISING HIS NEIGHBORS WERE SHOOTING A FIREARMS TOWARDS HIS RESIDENCE.
