INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

ON 04/16/2020 I SPOKE WITH MS. MARSHA HARGETT IN REFERENCE TO A SUSPICIOUS INCIDENT (POSSIBLE SCAM ATTEMPT).

MS. HARGETT STATED THAT APPROXIMATELY 3 PRIOR TO THE DATE OF THIS REPORT, SHE POSTED A RING FOR SALE ONLINE. A SUBJECT WHOM IDENTIFIED HIMSELF AS ROBERT MCGEE ADVISED MS. HARGETT THAT HE WANTED TO PURCHASE THE RING. THE SUBJECT THEN STATED HE WOULD SEND MS. HARGETT \$3500.00 VIA WESTERN UNION. MS. HARGETT AGREED TO SEND HIM THE RING ONCE SHE RECEIVED THE FUNDS.

MS. HARGETT STATED THAT A FEW DAYS LATER, SHE BEGAN GETTING MESSAGES FROM THE SUBJECT STATING THAT HE PAID HER MONEY AND DEMANDING THAT SHE PAY HIM BACK. MS. HARGETT TOLD THE SUBJECT THAT SHE NEVER RECEIVED MONEY FROM HIM. HE THEN CONTACTED HER USING A DIFFERENT NAME (ANDRE) AND TOLD HER THAT SHE OWED HIM \$2800.00 (A DIFFERENT AMOUNT FROM PREVIOUS). MS. HARGETT CONTINUED TO TELL THE SUBJECT THAT SHE DID NOT RECEIVE MONEY FROM HIM AND THAT SHE WAS GOING TO CONTACT LAW ENFORCEMENT. MS. HARGETT PROVIDED TWO PHONE NUMBERS THAT ARE BELIEVED TO BE "SPOOF NUMBERS". THE NUMBERS PROVIDED WERE (256) 602-1319 AND (941) 531-2047. I ATTEMPTED TO MAKE CONTACT WITH THE SUBJECT AT BOTH NUMBERS BUT MY ATTEMPTS WERE UNSUCCESSFUL.

MS. HARGETT STILL OBTAINS POSSESSION OF HER RING AND NO MONIES WERE SENT TO THE SUBJECT. REPORT FOR DOCUMENTATION AT THIS TIME.

ON 04/17/2020, I, DEPUTY R. SHAFER WAS DISPATCHED TO A CALL OVER THE PHONE IN REFERENCE TO IDENTITY FRAUD. BULLOCH COUNTY DISPATCH TRANSFERRED THE COMPLAINANT TO MY PHONE AND I SPOKE TO MS. HANNAH WOMACK.

MS. WOMACK ADVISED ME THAT ON 04/02/2020 THAT AN UNKNOWN SUBJECT HACKED INTO HER PHONE AND GOT ALL OF HER PERSONAL INFORMATION INCLUDING CELLPHONE, SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER, DATE OF BIRTH, NAME, AND MAILING ADDRESS. MS. WOMACK ADVISED ME THAT THE UNKNOWN SUBJECT USED HER PERSONAL INFORMATION TO CREATE A CHARGE CARD WITH KOHL'S STORE.

MS. WOMACK ADVISED ME THAT THE UNKNOWN SUBJECT USED THE CHARGE CARD FOR KOHL'S AND BOUGHT ITEMS FROM KOHL'S AND HAD IT SHIPPED TO THE PLACE OR RESIDENCE OF THE UNKNOWN SUBJECT.

MS. WOMACK ADVISED ME THAT SHE TRIED TO CALL THE CORPORATE OFFICE OF KOHL'S TO RECEIVE INFORMATION ON THIS TRANSACTION AND THAT THE WORKERS ON THE TELEPHONE COULD NOT GIVE HER ANY INFORMATION REGARDING THE PURCHASE AND MAKING OF THE CHARGE CARD, DUE TO THE FACT THAT KOHL'S WAS IN THE PROCESS DOING THEIR OWN INVESTIGATION.

MS. WOMACK ADVISED ME THAT SHE TOOK THE PROPER STEPS TO LOCK HER CREDIT USE AND EVERY OTHER THING SHE FELT THAT MAY HAVE BEEN COMPROMISED.

MS. WOMACK ADVISED THAT COOPERATE ADVISED HER THAT IF A DEPUTY WOULD CALL THEM THEY COULD GIVE ENLIGHTENMENT ON THE SITUATION. I TRIED TO MAKE CONTACT WITH KOHL'S COOPERATE OFFICE TO GATHER INFORMATION ABOUT THE INCIDENT AND MADE NEGATIVE CONTACT WITH ANYONE.

MS. WOMACK COULD NOT PROVIDE ME WITH NO EVIDENCE ON THE TRANSACTIONS AT THE TIME

I WILL CONDUCT A FOLLOWUP INVESTIGATION ABOUT THIS INCIDENT.

ON APRIL 18,2020 DEPUTIES WERE DISPATCHED TO 2522 NEESMITH PROCTOR RD, IN REFERENCE TO TWO INDIVIDUALS TRESSPASSING ON THE COMPLAINANTS PROPERTY.

UPON ARRIVAL, MYSELF AND DEPUTY SIMMONS MADE CONTACT WITH THE COMPLAINANT, MR WILKERSON. MR WILKERSON ADVISED HE WAS INSIDE WATCHING TV WHEN HE HEARD HIS DOGS START BARKING.
