ON 05/08/2020 I SPOKE WITH MS. LAKESHA ALLEN AT THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE IN REFERENCE TO A SUSPICIOUS INCIDENT.

MS. ALLEN STATED THAT SHE AND TOMARCO TAYLOR WERE PREVIOUSLY IN A ROMANTIC RELATIONSHIP. WHILE IN THE RELATIONSHIP MR. TAYLOR ASKED MS. ALLEN IF SHE KNEW HIS CHILD'S MOTHER, SHE REPLIED THAT SHE DID NOT.

MR. TAYLOR TOOK MS. ALLEN TO HIS CHILD'S MOTHERS HOME TO GIVE HER SOMETHING, MS. ALLEN STATED THAT SHE STAYED IN THE VEHICLE WHILE MR. TAYLOR ENTERED THE HOME. SOON AFTER, MR. MS. ALLEN STATED THAT AFTER THIS INCIDENT, AN UNKNOWN PERSON CREATED A FAKE FACEBOOK PROFILE USING HER NAME AND PHONE NUMBER AND BEGAN SENDING MESSAGES TO MR. TAYLOR (WHICH APPEARED TO BE FROM MS. ALLEN) THREATENING HIS CHILDS MOTHER.

MS. ALLEN STATED THAT SHE BELIEVES MR. TAYLORS CHILDS MOTHER'S NAME IS JAZMINE JONES, SHE IS UNSURE IF THIS IS WHO CREATED THE FAKE ACCOUNT. A WITNESS STATEMENT WAS COMPLETED BY THE VICTIM AND ATTACHED TO THE LINKED FILES TAB OF THIS REPORT. MS. ALLEN WANTED THIS REPORT FOR DOCUMENTATION PURPOSES AT THIS TIME.

On 05/09/2020 at 0533 I was turning on to Harville Road off of Highway 67, I saw the vehicle listed in the report parked on the side of the road. I noticed that the driver appeared to be sleeping. I turned my blue lights on and exited my vehicle to attempt to wake the driver to make sure he was ok.

When I approached the driver side window I knocked and asked the driver if he was ok, their was no response. I could tell he was breathing so after several attempts to wake him I opened the vehicle door. that was when I smelled a strong odor of alcohol and green marijuana coming from the vehicle.

I shook the driver to attempt to wake him again, this time he did respond my groaning. I could see a large plastic bin filled with an alcoholic beverage called "Hunch Punch" it is usually several types of alcohol in a large container that is mixed together with fruit. Due to my knowledge, training and experience coupled with the drivers inability to wake up and the strong odor of alcohol coming from his person and the vehicle I determined that the level of unresponsiveness from the driver was due to alcohol and marijuana consumption.

I noticed a hand gun sitting on the passenger seat in plain view, I retrieved the firearm and made the weapon safe. It was at this time that other deputies arrived on scene and I was able to take my attention off of him and leave him with the other deputies. I ran the firearm through GCIC database to make sure it was not stolen, it came back not stolen.

The other Deputies were able to wake the driver and determine his name was Mr. Jenson Hill, we had Mr. Hill exit the vehicle and stand in front of my patrol vehicle. I then conducted a Probable Cause search of the vehicle due to the odor of marijuana, I located a clear plastic baggy with a green leafy substance inside that I believe to be marijuana.

Mr. Hill was placed under arrest and transported to the Bulloch County Jail for further processing and the vehicle was towed.
