**INCIDENT NARRATIVE:**

I responded to the Bulloch County Sheriff's Office Lobby in reference to someone wanting to report fraud. Upon arrival, I spoke with the listed complainant Wilton, who stated her roommate's friend Taylor (listed suspect), was driving Wilton around on April 25th, 2020 to help Wilton run errands. Wilton stated, at some point in the trip Wilton left her phone and wallet in the vehicle with Taylor. Wilton stated, she noticed her PayPal account was used on April 27th, 2020, with a purchase of \$71.83 and a fee of \$2.38 = \$74.21, with an account transaction number: 3MX63735E2267814C. Wilton stated she also noticed \$240.00 in cash from her stimulus check and a safety plan from DFCS was missing from her wallet. Wilton suspected Taylor was the one who took the item and used her PayPal account and when Wilton confronted Taylor about the issue Taylor said she would give her a money order. Wilton stated, Taylor never gave her the money order and Wilton heard Taylor had opened a credit card in Wilton's name. Wilton stated, while she was getting her bills in order she notice she didn't receive one from Title Max. Wilton stated, when she called to inquire about this the address on file had been changed and replaced with Taylor's address.

I advised Wilton of available remedies to resolve this issue, as well as Magistrate Court proceedings.

**INCIDENT NARRATIVE:**

ON 05/20/2020 I SPOKE WITH MR. BLAKE PROTZMAN VIA TELEPHONE IN REFERENCE TO A SUSPICIOUS INCIDENT.

MR. PROTZMAN STATED THAT HE RENTS THE PROPERTY AT THE INCIDENT LOCATION ON THIS REPORT THROUGH PMG PROPERTIES. HE CONTINUED TO STATE THAT HIS LEASE ENDS ON 05/30/2020. AS AGREED IN THE CONTRACT, THE PROPERTY CAN BE SHOWN TO POTENTIAL FUTURE TENANTS WITH A 24 HOUR NOTICE TO MR. PROTZMAN.

MR. PROTZMAN STATED THAT DURING THE INCIDENT TIMES ON THIS REPORT, HE BELIEVED SOMEONE FROM PMG RENTALS SHOWED THE HOME TO A POTENTIAL TENANT AND THAT HE WAS NOT NOTIFIED. MR. PROTZMAN STATED THAT HE HAS KNOWLEDGE OF THIS DUE TO THE DOOR LEADING INTO THE HOME FROM INSIDE THE GARAGE WAS DEAD BOLTED FROM THE INSIDE AND WHEN HE LEFT THE LOCATION PRIOR, THE DOOR WAS UNLOCKED.

I MADE CONTACT WITH PMG PROPERTIES AND SPOKE WITH MR. CADE WINDHAM. MR. WINDHAM STATED THAT MR. PROTZMAN WAS NOTIFIED AT A SECONDARY PHONE NUMBER THAT WAS PROVIDED TO THEM ON 01/23/2019. THAT NUMBER WAS PROVIDED ALONG WITH THE PHONE NUMBER THAT HE PROVIDED TO ME TODAY. MR. WINDHAM DID STATE THAT THEY HAVE CONTACTED MR. PROTZMAN AT THIS NUMBER IN THE PAST BUT MORE RECENTLY HE HAS BEEN CONTACTED AT THE NUMBER THAT WAS PROVIDED TO ME THIS DATE. MR. WINDHAM STATED THAT HE IS UNAWARE IF MR. PROTZMAN REQUESTED THE "OLD" PHONE NUMBER TO BE REMOVED FROM HIS FILE HOWEVER, HE DID NOT SEE A RECORD OF THE CHANGE.

MR. WINDHAM STATED THAT HE WOULD REACH OUT TO MR. PROTZMAN AND APOLOGIZE FOR THE MISUNDERSTANDING. MR. PROTZMAN WANTED THIS INCIDENT CONDUCTED FOR DOCUMENTATION PURPOSES ONLY. NO DAMAGE WAS FOUND IN OR AROUND THE INCIDENT LOCATION AND NO ITEMS WERE MISSING.
