On May 8, 2020 at approximately 1135 hours, Deputy Mallard responded to 33a Archie Mitchell Rd in reference to an unknown complaint received by Bulloch Central 911 due to a language barrier. Dep Mallard made contact with the complainant/victim identified as Yassin Mohamad who was pacing back and forth in his yard and appeared to be in disturbed state of mind. Dep Mallard ask him how he could help him and Mr Mohamad stated that there were two people that were trying to kill him and that he needed to go to the US Embassy. Dep Mallard ask him to go into more detail of who was trying to kill him and what their names were. Mr Mohamad was un able provide a name or any description of the subjects and continued to ramble in broken english and reverting back to Arabic.

Mohamed that he would take to him outside. Mohamed then got his roommate to come outside who was also a contract worker for Claxton Poultry. This subject started telling Dep Mallard that Mohamed was sick and that these people that were trying to kill him were not real. At this time Mohamed asked both Dep Mallard and his roommate to follow him to the field adjacent to the resident. Mohamed then stated that he could see them standing in the field. Dep Mallard observed no one in the field and started to believe that Mr Mohamed was in a deranged state of mind. Dep Mallard attempted several times to get Mr Mohamed to go see a Dr to try and get help, however he insisted these people were real and believed they were going to kill him. He refused to go to the hospital and only wanted to be taken to the US Embassy. Dep Mallard advised him that he could not take him to the US Embassy but that if he wanted to arrange a way to go back to his country of Suddan that he could but he recommended going to see a Doctor. Mr Mohamed refused at this time. Dep Mallard advised Mr Mohamed to not call 911 for this but that he needed a doctor to be able get help. Dep Mallard asked the roommate and neighbor to see if they would assist getting Mr Mohamed some help but they refused to offer any help for the situation. Dep Mallard advised Mr Mohamed ofall the available remedies and returned to service.

At approximately 1246 the Evans County Sheriff's Office received a complaint about a black male running into traffic and hiding in bushes near the intersection of Highway 169 and Archie Mitchell Rd. Dep Mallard arrived back on scene and saw Mr Mohamed moving frantically in the ditch in front of the white house located at the intersection. Dep Mallard asked Mohamed several times to sit down on the grass before finally getting him calm enough to find out what was wrong again. Mr Mohamed was still seeing two imaginary men that he believed were going to try and kill him and is now putting himself and others in danger due to his mental state. Dep Mallard advised dispatch to make contact with Evans Memorial and advise them that he had a mental patient and see if they would take him in for a mental evaluation in order to get him placed in a mental facility to get him help. Dispatched advised that the ER and Evans Memorial would take him and Dep Mallard asked Mohamed to sit in his patrol car so he could take him to the Hospital to get help and he complied willingly.

Dep Mallard got Mohamed to the Hospital at approximately 1305 hours and escorted him into the ER. The on duty nurse advised the Dep Mallard needed to show him to the front reception area so that he could be registered in. Dep Mallard then assisted him to where he needed to go before turning him over to the Hospital Staff and returning to service.

At Approximately 1650 hours, Evans Memorial called the Evans County Sheriff's Office requesting a deputy and stated that Mr Mohamed was refusing to take medication and acting up. Dep Mallard arrived on scene at approximately 1704 hours and when he walked in the back door of the ER he saw Mr Mohamed walking around the counter holding a sheet of white paper. Dep Mallard asked the nurse what was going on and she stated that Mr Mohamed had been discharged. Dep Mallard ask her what happened to Mr Mohamed being issued a 1013 and going to a mental facility and stated that he was not mentally ill and that he just did not want to take medication. Dep Mallard explained the events leading up to him transporting Mr Mohamed to the hospital to get help and she continued to state that he was in a sound state of mind because she was able to talk to him and get the days date and he was able to write her name in Arabic. Dep Mallard informed her that he still believes some one is trying to kill him and that he was running in and out of traffic. However the nurse and doctor stated that he was not a candidate for a 1013 because he was not suicidal. At this time Mr Mohamed stated that the people that were trying to kill him were around the corner and the he could hear them whispering. Dep Mallard brought this behavior to the nurses attention and she stated that she believes he is bringing up something that may have happened in Suddan. Dep Mallard advised her again that he was not in a sound state of mind and he needed to be sent to a mental facility or he would be back out in the roads putting himself and other in danger. The Nurse just stated that he needed to get in contact with his contractor and figure out of to return to his country. She gave Mr Mohamed a white sticky note with a number and told him he needed to contact a Marie Subject. She then stated that he needed to take his medicine or throw it in the trash that she did not care. She then restated that he had been discharged and requested assistance showing Mr Mohamed the way out. Dep Mallard assisted Mohamed out the door and he stated that he did not want to go back home because it was not safe and asked where Claxton Poultry was. Dep Mallard advised him on how to get
