**INCIDENT NARRATIVE:**

WHILE PATROLLING ON S.R. 25, I CHECKED A VEHICLE SPEEDING SOUTH BOUND ON 25 AT 111 MILES PER HOUR. I CHECKED THE SPEEDING AUTO AT THE INTERSECTION OF BUTTERMILK ROAD AND S.R. 25. I TURNED MY PATROL VEHICLE AROUND, AS I WAS PATROLLING TRAVELING NORTH.

I SAW THE VEHICLE TURN INTO THE STORE AT 25 AND ROCKY FORD ROAD, THERE IS WHERE THE STOP FINALIZED. I MADE CONTACT WITH THE DRIVER, IDENTIFIED AS FELICIA RENA SMITH, BY HER VALID GEORGIA DRIVERS LICENSE. I ALSO NOTICED THAT THERE WERE SEVERAL CHILDREN IN THE VEHICLE THAT WERE NOT PROPERLY RESTRAINED. THE ODOR OF MARIJUANA WAS VERY STRONG COMING FROM THE VEHICLE. I REQUESTED A SECOND UNIT, AS I EXPLAINED TO THE DRIVER AND THE MALE PASSENGER, IDENTIFIED AS JOSEPH MICHAEL WIGGINS THAT A SEARCH OF THE VEHICLE WAS GOING TO BE CONDUCTED. A SEARCH OF THE VEHICLE DETERMINED THAT JOSEPH THREW A SMALL BAG CONTAINING THE MARIJUANA UNDER THE VEHICLE AS HE EXITED. INVESTIGATOR T. SMALLAGEN SAW IT WHEN HE ARRIVED ON SCENE. THERE WAS ALSO LOCATED A WEAPON, THAT WAS RAN AND WAS NOT STOLEN. MR. WIGGINS POSSESSED A GUN PERMIT.

On June 26, 2020 at approximately 2013 hours I, Corporal Juarez, responded to the listed location in reference to a theft by taking. Upon arrival I met with the complainant, Gregory King, who stated items were taken from a trailer outside his residence. Gregory described the items to be two back pack blower motors, one being a Stihl BR 500, and the other being an Echo BR 600. Gregory stated that he usually has his lawn equipment chained on his utility trailer, however, he has given his two son's the responsibility of taking care of the equipment, and they failed to chain the items to the trailer.

I asked Gregory if there were any possible suspects, and he stated that there is a male subject who walks the streets during all hours of the night. Gregory stated that he wasn't sure what his name was or where he resides, but everyone calls him "Crack head Charles."

After receiving information from Gregory, he was informed a report would be documented. At this time, Gregory could not provide any serial numbers for the items that were taken, therefore, no items could be added into GCIC. An investigation will follow when further information is received, or there are leads to a possible suspect.
