ON JUNE 29, 2020 I DEPUTY K. KELLEY AND DEPUTY I. JOHNSON WAS DISPATCH TO THE AREA OF HWY 46 AND ALMA LN IN REFERENCE TO A TRAILER BEING LEFT IN THE ROADWAY.

UPON OUR ARRIVAL WE LOCATED THE TRAILER PARKED IN THE WEST BOUND LANE OF TRAFFIC MAKING IT UNSAFE FOR ONCOMING TRAFFIC AND PASSING VEHICLES. AT THAT TIME, WE CALLED FOR THE LIST WRECKER WHICH WAS DOLLAR WRECKER SERVICE LOCATED ON 301 SOUTH. A CHECK OF THE TAG THAT WAS ON THE TRAILER CAME BACK TO A LUTHER CRAWFORD OF STATESBORO. THEIR WAS NO PHONE NUMBER ATTACHED THE TAG INFORMATION SO WE WERE UNABLE TO MAKE CONTACT WITH THE OWNER.
