On June 13, 2020 at approximately 1223 hours I, Corporal Juarez, responded to the listed location in reference to a theft by taking report. Upon arrival I met with the complainant, Russell Collins, who stated items were taken from his property while he was away. Russell Described the items to be a Porter Cable air compressor - red tank with a black motor, and a gray waterbug with a Mlnn Kota troller motor. Russell stated that items were under a shed next to his residence, and he last seen the items on 6/9/2020. Russell believes the items were taken between the dates of 6/10/2020 - 6/12/2020.

According to Russell, there is a possible suspect known as Steven Collins. Russell stated that nearly a month ago Steven became upset with him regarding a dating relationship that Steven was involved in. Russell isn't sure if Steven is the offender, but he believes that Steven may commit an act for retaliation due to their ongoing conflicts. Russell was asked where Steven resides and he stated that his doesn't know his address, and it's not in Bulloch County.

After receiving additional information from Russell, he was informed an investigation would be conducted regarding the theft that occurred at his residence. At this time, the serial number for the air compressor has not been able to be retrieved, but the Identification Number for the boat was obtained and entered into GCIC as stolen. Furthermore, the case will be turned over to the Criminal Investigation's Division.

I WAS ABLE TO MEET WITH THE COMPLAINANT WHO STATED THAT WHEN HE CAME HOME TO CLEAN OF HIS FIREARM HE NOTICED THAT IT WAS MISSING. HE STATED THAT HE USUALLY KEEPS THE FIREARM IN HIS SIDE DRESSER INSIDE THE CASE WITH A GUN LOCK ON IT.

THE COMPLAINANT ADVISED THAT THE LAST TIME HE REMEMBERED SEEING THE FIREARM WAS THE WEDNESDAY PRIOR BECAUSE HE HAD IT OUT TO INSPECT IT. HE THEN INFORMED ME THAT ONE OF HIS FRIENDS RECENTLY WAS STAYING WITH HIM FOR A SHORT TIME BUT WHEN THEY LEFT TO GO BACK TO THEIR HOME THEY ACCIDENTALLY TOOK HIS HOUSE KEY WITH THEM BACK TO ATLANTA. DUE TO HIS FRIEND TAKING HIS, HE STATED HE HAD TO UTILIZE HIS BEDROOM WINDOW TO GET IN HIS HOUSE. HE STATED THAT HE BELIEVES SOMEONE MIGHT HAVE SEEN HIM DO SO AND MAY HAVE WENT IN THE WINDOW AS WELL.

THE COMPLAINANT WAS ABLE TO SHOW ME THE BACK BEDROOM WHERE HE HAS HAD TO COME IN. THERE WERE NO SIGNS OF FORCED ENTRY AT ALL. ACCORDING TO THE COMPLAINANT, THE FIREARM WAS THE ONLY ITEM TAKEN FROM THE RESIDENCE. HE ALSO WAS ABLE TO PROVIDE ME WITH A SERIAL NUMBER FOR HIS FIREARM.
