When I spoke with Ms. Riley, she stated that she has been dating a Mr. Danny Pfister. Ms. Riley stated, she has been trying to break up with Mr. Pfister for a couple months now and every time she tries Mr. Pfister threatens to harm her and her family. Ms. Riley stated, she has told Mr. Pfister to stop contacting her multiple times but he will not and will send her over 20 messages a day. Ms. Riley stated, Mr. Pfister has also threatened to come to her place of work to take her vehicle while she is at work.

I advised Ms. Riley to save all of the messages that she has received from Mr. Pfister and to block his number. Ms. Riley was worried that Mr. Pfister would show up to her residence and she was advised to call the Sheriff's Office if he does. I contacted Ms. Riley via phone to see if she could send me the messages and she sent me the messages from just on Saturday 06-13-2020, but Ms. Riley stated that Mr. Pfister said the threats verbally. Ms. Riley was unsure on if she wanted to pursue charges but she stated that she wanted Mr. Pfister to stop contacting her. I advised Ms. Riley that the incident would be documented if she decided she wanted to pursue charges and explained to her how to go to magistrate court to obtain a warrant. Ms. Riley was also advised of all other remedies. Nothing further.

When I arrived on scene I spoke with the alleged offender a Mr. Aaron McBride he stated, that his sons girlfriend a Ms. Jaime Fitzwater had been in a verbal altercation. McBride said that his grandkids kept locking the doors in the house and he couldn't unlock them because he doesn't have a key for them.

McBride stated he told Fitzwater that he was sick of the kids locking the doors and that he would have to kick in the doors or shoot them open. Fitzwater side of the story was that McBride said he would "kick in the doors or just shoot through it and bodies would start to drop and then she would be upset when her kids were dead."

McBride had admitted to me that he did have guns in the home. I explained to Fitzwater that she could charge him with Terroristic Threats And Acts, she said she did not want to press any charges. She just didn't want him to kick them out of the house like he said he was going to, Fitzwater signed a release of prosecution and both parties agreed to go to the bedrooms and go to sleep.
