INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

ON THE ABOVE DATE AND TIME, I RESPONDED TO A CALL IN REFERENCE TO A DOMESTIC DISPUTE. UPON MY ARRIVAL, I MET WITH THE COMPLAINANT WHO STATED THAT SHE AND HER HUSBAND HAD RECENTLY GOTTEN INTO AN ARGUMENT ABOUT A CHECK. SHE STATED THAT HE BECAME UPSET WITH HER AFTER NOT BEING ABLE TO FIND A CHECK HE HAD. SHE ALSO STATED THAT DURING THE EXCHANGE HE WAS ATTEMPTING TO GET HER TO HIT HIM SO THAT HE COULD HIT HER BACK. THE COMPLAINANT ALSO MADE ME AWARE THAT HER HUSBAND SUFFERS FROM BIPOLAR DISORDER AND THAT HIS MEDICINE HAS NOT BEEN RIGHT AND THEY WERE ATTEMPTING TO GET IT RIGHT WITH THE DOCTORS.

I WAS ABLE TO SPEAK WITH THE OFFENDER WHO WAS ABLE TO CORROBORATE THAT THE ARGUMENT WAS OVER A CHECK. HE STATED THAT HE ASKED HER WHERE A CHECK HE WROTE HAD WENT WHERE HE STATED SHE SAID SHE DIDN'T KNOW. AN ARGUMENT ENSUED BETWEEN THE TWO SHORTLY AFTER THIS.
