ON 07/16/2020 AT APPROXIMATELY 1901 HOURS I, DEPUTY BARRICK, RESPONDED TO 20551 E HIGHWAY 80 LOT 2 FOR AN UNRULY JUVENILE. UPON MY ARRIVAL I MADE CONTACT WITH AN ERICA MORIVAL WHO STATED HER JUVENILE DAUGHTER HAD BEEN ATTACKED BY A JUVENILE BOY. WHILE SPEAKING WITH THE TEENAGE JUVENILE SHE STATED THAT THE JUVENILE BOY HAD SLAPPED HER UPSIDE THE HEAD WITH A PIECE OF BROOM AND BIT HER LEG. WHEN I ASKED THE JUVENILE TEENAGER WHY THE JUVENILE BOY DID IT SHE SAID THEY WERE MAKING FUN OF HIM BECAUSE THE JUVENILE BOY TOOK HIS SHIRT OFF AND SHE CALLED HIM A STRIPPER. The Complainant kept the conversation short because she was afraid to know if what he was saying was true. The complainant then decided to block the individual from contacting her, and she immediately came to the Sheriff's Office to file a report. Due the incident possible occurring in Savannah, the complainant was advised to contact Savannah Police Department as well. Furthermore, a report was documented for Aid to Other Agency.
