DEPUTY JAILER CAMPBELL NOT WANTING TO ENGAGE IN A CONFRONTATION TRIED TALKING TO INMATE CAMPBELL CONVINCING HIM TO GATHER HIS BELONGINGS TO BE MOVED. DEPUTY JAILER CAMPBELL STATED THAT INMATE LAWTON STEPPED TOWARDS HIM SWINGING WITH HIS LEFT HAND AND MADE CONTACT WITH DEPUTY JAILER CAMPBELL'S CHIN. DEPUTY JAILER CAMPBELL GRABBED INMATE LAWTON AND RESTRAINED HIM UNTIL OTHER JAILERS COULD COME TO ASSIST HIM. INMATE LAWTON WAS PLACED IN THE RESTRAINT CHAIR WITHOUT FURTHER INCIDENT.

INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

ON 7/11/2020 I SPOKE WITH MR. MATTHEW MARSHALL IN REGARDS OF HIS EX GIRLFRIEND, TINA SHOTTON HARASSING HIM. MR. MARSHALL ADVISED THAT MRS. SHOTTON KEEPS TEXTING HIS PHONE, ALONG WITH OTHER FAMILY MEMBERS PHONES NON STOP HARASSING THEM. MR. MARSHALL ADVISED THAT HE AND MRS. SHOTTON WERE SUPPOSED TO MOVE INTO A HOUSE TOGETHER IN A FEW MONTHS BUT SHE HAS GONE CRAZY AND THEY ARE NO LONGER GOING TO MOVE IN TOGETHER. MR. MARSHALL ADVISED THAT MRS. SHOTTON IS CURRENTLY STAYING IN FLORIDA BUT KEEPS THREATENING TO SHOW UP AT HIS FAMILIES HOUSE TO HURT THEM. MR. MARSHALL STATED THAT HE IS GOING TO SET UP A TIME WITH MRS. SHOTTON FOR HER TO COME GET HER BELONGINGS OUT OF THEIR STORAGE UNIT. MR. MARSHALL WAS ADVISED TO CALL US IF HE NEEDED A DEPUTY TO STAND BY WHEN MRS. SHOTTON RETRIEVES HER PROPERTY. AT THIS TIME, MR. MARSHALL JUST WANTED THIS INFORMATION DOCUMENTED IN CASE OF FURTHER INCIDENTS. MR. MARSHALL ADVISED IF THIS CONTINUES HE WILL GET A RESTRAINING ORDER.

INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

ON 07/11/2020, I, DEPUTY R. SHAFER WAS DISPATCHED TO 356 TWIN FORKS ROAD IN REFERENCE TO A BATTERY, CRIMINAL TRESPASS THAT HAD ALREADY OCCURRED. WHEN I ARRIVED ON SCENE I SPOKE TO THE COMPLAINANT AND VICTIMS, MR. BRYAN GRIFFIN, AND MRS. GRIFFIN. BOTH ADVISED THAT THEY WENT ON THEIR PROPERTY BEHIND 899 TWIN FORKS ROAD AND MS. SHARON SAMBITO WAS ON THEIR PROPERTY DRIVING AROUND ON A SIDE BY SIDE, THEY TOLD MS. SAMBITO THAT SHE NEEDS TO GET OFF THEIR PROPERTY. FURTHER ADVISING THAT MS. SAMBITO THREATENED THEM AND CHARGED TOWARD MRS. GRIFFIN AND BIT HER MIDDLE FINGER ON HER RIGHT HAND, MR. GRIFFIN TRIED TO PULL MS. SAMBITO OFF MS. GRIFFIN AND THAT'S WHEN SHE BIT MR. GRIFFIN OVER THE RIBS ON HIS LEFT SIDE.

EMS ARRIVED ON SCENE AND INSPECTED AND CLEANED THEIR WOUNDS, AND ADVISED MR. AND MRS. GRIFFIN TO GET A TETANUS SHOT. I ASKED MR. AND MRS. GRIFFIN IF THEY WOULD LIKE TO SERVE MS. SAMBITO WITH CRIMINAL TRESPASS. BOTH ADVISED YES. I ASKED MR. AND MRS. GRIFFIN IF THEY WOULD LIKE TO PRESS CHARGES. MR. AND MRS. GRIFFIN ADVISED NOT AT THE TIME. I REFERRED BOTH TO MAGISTRATE IF THEY CHANGED THEIR MINDS.

I WENT TO 899 TWIN FORKS TO SPEAK TO MS. SAMBITO AFTER TALKING TO THE GRIFFINS. MS. SAMBITO ADVISED SHE HAD A VIDEO OF WHAT HAPPENED. THE VIDEO ONLY SHOWED ONE SIDE OF THE CONFRONTATION AFTER SHE BIT MS. GRIFFIN. MS. SAMBITO ADVISED THAT SHE HAD MARKINGS ON HER FACE FROM THE CONFRONTATION. I REFERRED MS. SAMBITO TO MAGISTRATE COURT IF SHE FELT THE NEED TO ISSUE WARRANTS, DUE TO THE CURRENT POLICY WITHIN THE JAIL. I SERVED MS. SAMBITO VERBALLY WITH CRIMINAL TRESPASS WHILE TALKING TO HER, AND SHE WANTED MR. AND MRS. GRIFFIN SERVED AS WELL, DUE TO THEM COMING THROUGH HER PROPERTY TO GET TO THEIRS. AFTER I FINISHED TALKING TO MS. SAMBITO I SERVED MR. AND MRS. GRIFFIN WITH CRIMINAL TRESPASS VIA PHONE.

BOTH PARTIES WERE SERVED WITH CRIMINAL TRESPASS AND ADVISED OF OBTAINING A COPY OF THE REPORT FOR PERSONAL RECORDS AND THE USE OF GOING TO MAGISTRATE COURT TO OBTAINING WARRANTS.

INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

ON THE ABOVE DATE AND TIME, I RESPONDED TO A CALL IN REFERENCE TO A DOMESTIC DISPUTE. UPON MY ARRIVAL, I MET WITH THE COMPLAINANT WHO STATED THAT HER HUSBAND THAT SHE'S BEEN SEPARATED FROM WAS DESTROYING THINGS IN THE HOUSE. SHE STATED THEY HAD BEEN APART BUT HE RECENTLY CAME BACK TO ATTEMPT TO WORK OUT THEIR PROBLEMS.

THE COMPLAINANT ADVISED THAT THEY HAD BEEN ARGUING SINCE ABOUT LUNCHTIME TODAY. SHE STATED THAT THEY WERE BICKERING BACK AND FORTH AT EACH OTHER BUT THE OFFENDER BECAME AGITATED AND BEGAN TO BREAK SOME GLASSES IN THE LIVING ROOM. SHE THEN SAID WHEN HE STARTED TO DO THIS SHE LEFT THE RESIDENCE TO GO TO HER SISTER'S HOUSE. SHE ADVISED THAT SHE RETURNED A WHILE LATER TO HIM STILL THERE. THE COMPLAINANT THEN SAID THAT THEY WERE SITTING ON THE COUCH TOGETHER AND THEY ONCE AGAIN STARTED ARGUING. THIS TIME, SHE STATED THAT HE BECAME ANGRY AND PICKED UP THE LIVING MANTLE AND THREW IT DOWN CAUSING IT TO BREAK.

I THEN WAS ABLE TO SPEAK WITH THE OFFENDER AS WELL. HE STATED THAT THIS WHOLE ARGUMENT STARTED BECAUSE THE COMPLAINANT SUSPECTED HIM OF CHEATING. HE STATED THIS WAS THE CASE BECAUSE SHE SAW ON HIS PHONE WHERE ANOTHER FEMALE SENT HIM A VIDEO OF HERSELF PARTYING. HE STATED THAT DURING THIS SHE BECAME ANGRY AND STARTED TO THROW THE GLASSES AROUND THE LIVING ROOM. ALSO, WHEN IT COMES TO THE MANTLE THAT WAS BROKEN, HE STATED THAT HE WAS PICKING IT UP TO LEAVE WITH IT SINCE IT WAS HIS AND SHE PUSHED HIM CAUSING HIM TO DROP IT AND BREAK IT. HE ALSO STATED SHE PUSHED HIM AND CAUSED HIM TO FALL ON THE COFFEE TABLE.

WHILE QUESTIONING BOTH PARTIES THEY BOTH ADMITTED TO PUTTING THEIR HANDS ON ONE ANOTHER. WHILE INVESTIGATING, I WAS ABLE TO OBSERVE THE DAMAGE CAUSED IN THE ALTERCATION. THERE WAS BROKEN GLASS IN THE LIVING ROOM AND ALSO THE MANTLE WAS BROKEN. NEITHER PARTY HAD ANY MARKS ON THEIR PERSONS. DUE TO EXTREMELY CONFLICTING STORIES, NO PRIMARY AGGRESSOR COULD BE DETERMINED THEREFORE NO ARREST WAS BE MADE. THE OFFENDER OPTED TO LEAVE WHICH IS ULTIMATELY WHAT THE COMPLAINANT WANTED TO HAPPEN. WE WERE ABLE TO ESCORT THE OFFENDER OFF OF THE PROPERTY. REPORT FOR DOCUMENTATION.
