**INCIDENT NARRATIVE:**

ON 08/03/2020 I SPOKE WITH MS. BRANDI MALLARD AND HER JUVENILE SON REGARDING A BURGLARY.

MS. MALLARD AND HER SON STATED THAT MS. JESSICA LEIGH SMITH (MONTFORD) AND HER HUSBAND, JAMES "JIM" CULBERTSON HAD BEEN ALLOWED TO GO FISHING ON THE PROPERTY LISTED AT THE INCIDENT DATE ON THIS REPORT.

MS. MALLARD STATED THAT MR. CULBERTSON INQUIRED ABOUT USING THE WELDER LISTED IN THE PROPERTY SECTION LISTED ON THIS REPORT AND MS. MALLARD ADVISED HIM THAT HE COULD NOT USE IT BECAUSE IT BELONGED TO HER JUVENILE SON AND THAT HE USES IT FOR WORK PURPOSES.

MS. MALLARDS JUVENILE SON LATER NOTICED THAT THE WELDER WAS MISSING FROM THE SHOP LOCATED ON THE PROPERTY NEAR THE POND WHERE MR. CULBERTSON AND MS. SMITH HAD BEEN FISHING. THE JUVENILE SON ALSO STATED THAT HE LOCATED A BEER CAN SITTING RIGHT WHERE THE WELDER WAS PREVIOUSLY LOCATED. UPON THIS DISCOVERY, THE JUVENILE SON WALKED DOWN BY THE POND WHERE MR. CULBERTSON AND MS. SMITH WERE FISHING AND FOUND THE SAME KIND OF BEER CANS.

MS. MALLARD DID SEND TEXT MESSAGES TO MS. SMITH ASKING IF MR. CULBERTSON TOOK THE WELDER. MS. SMITH ADVISED VIA TEXT THAT HE DID IN FACT TAKE THE WELDER TO USE IT, AND THAT SHE DID NOT KNOW ABOUT THE INCIDENT UNTIL A FEW DAYS LATER. SHE ALSO ADVISED THAT THEY WERE IN FLORIDA AS OF RIGHT NOW BUT THE WELDER WAS LOCKED SAFELY IN A STORAGE SHED AND THAT THEY WOULD RETURN IT. MS. CULBERTSON AND MS. SMITH BOTH HAVE ACTIVE WARRANTS THROUGH G.C.I.C. I WAS UNABLE TO CONTACT EITHER OF THEM AT THIS TIME VIA THE PHONE NUMBERS PROVIDED.

**INCIDENT NARRATIVE:**

On August 3, 2020 at approximately 2230 hours I, Corporal Juarez, responded to 5929 Black Creek Church road in reference to a Civil Matter. Upon arrival I met with the complainant, Wilbur Wilson, who advised he has recently had issues with tenants that reside in a residence that he owns, located at 5955 Black Creek Church road. Mr. Wilson advised that the tenants are two of his daughters, Katie Wilson and Carrol Wilson, and the other female is a friend of theirs, known as Stephanie Restrepo.

Mr. Wilson advised that he allowed Katie and Carrol to reside at the residence, and he only charges them \$100 a month for rent. Since their stay, they have invited multiple individuals to reside at the residence without his permission. Mr. Wilson has tried to reason with them, but they refuse to adhere to his request of not inviting other individuals to stay at the residence.

After speaking with Mr. Wilson, I then met with the three tenants currently at 5955 Black Creek Church road. Katie and Carrol advised that they have resided at the residence for approximately one year, and did admit to allowing Stephanie Restrepo move in the residence. According to all three tenants, Stephanie stated that she has been living in the residence for nearly three months, and all her belongings are there. All three individuals did provide mailed documents that included the listed address with their names.

After speaking with the tenants, I then returned and spoke with Mr. Wilson regarding the matter. I informed him of why the tenants could not be forced out of the residence due to it being a civil issue. Mr. Wilson was informed of the proper procedures to file for an eviction through Magistrate Court.
