Upon my arrival, Georgia State Trooper Aaron Digiacombo was already conducting field sobriety on Mr. Carlos Jimenez. Other deputies went to check on the second driver of the accident where she needed EMS. Trooper Digiacombo placed Mr. Jimenez under arrest for DUI. While Trooper Digiacombo was searching Mr. Jimenez incident to the arrest, he found in Mr. Jimenez's wallet a small clear baggy with two blue pills inside. I then helped Trooper Digiacombo conduct a search of Mr. Jimenez's vehicle but no contraband was found. K9 Deputy arrived on scene and conducted a search of the area of the vehicle and the K9 alerted to a glass jar laying in the grass. I picked up the jar and handed it over to Trooper Digiacombo.

Mr. Jimenez had minor cuts from glass and the driver of vehicle two Ms. Kimberly Miles was transported to East Georgia Regional Medical center for further treatment of her injuries. Drug Investigator Travis Smalleagan was dispatched to the scene and took possession of all narcotics. Both vehicles were towed by Deloaches towing and Mr. Jimenez was transported to the Bulloch County Jail with no further issues.

ON 08/24/2020, I, DEPUTY R. SHAHER WAS DISPATCHED TO 1240 OWENS ROAD REGARDING A DISAGREEMENT. UPON ARRIVAL I SPOKE TO THE COMPLAINANT MS. ERICA HOLLAND. MS. HOLLAND ADVISED SHE WAS AT THE RESIDENCE OF 1213 OWENS ROAD VISITING MR. ANTHONY JOHNSON. MS. HOLLAND ADVISED THAT WHILE SHE WAS AT MR. JOHNSON'S RESIDENCE AND HE TRIED TO FORCE HIMSELF ONTO HER AND IN THE PROCESS HE SCRATCHED HER WRIST, LEG, AND HIT HER ON THE LEFT SIDE OF THE FOREHEAD. I ASKED MS. HOLLAND STARTED BREAKING THINGS IN HIS HOUSE. THAT IS ALL MR. JOHNSON WOULD TELL THE OTHER DEPUTY. DURING THE TIME THAT THE OTHER DEPUTY WAS AT MR. JOHNSON'S RESIDENCE, I ASKED MS. HOLLAND AGAIN IF SHE WOULD LIKE TO PRESS CHARGES. MS. HOLLAND ADVISED THAT SHE DID NOT WANT TO PRESS CHARGES.

HOLLAND ONCE MORE IF SHE WANTED TO PRESS CHARGES. MS. HOLLAND THEN ADVISED THAT SHE DID WANT TO PRESS CHARGES. I REFERRED MS. HOLLAND TO MAGISTRATE COURT TO GET HER OWN WARRANT. I TRANSPORTED MS. HOLLAND TO THE POJO'S ON 301 SOUTH AT I-16, SO SHE COULD CALL FOR A RIDE TO TAKE HER HOME.
