INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

ON 08/25/2020 I SPOKE WITH MR. CLEMON ROBINSON AT THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE IN REFERENCE TO A THEFT INCIDENT.

MR. ROBINSON STATED THAT ON 07/23/2020 AT APPROXIMATELY 19:00HRS HE PICKED UP 12 CHAIRS AND TWO 6 FT FOLDING TABLES FOR MR. MAURICE HILL (OWNER OF THE TABLES AND CHAIRS) AFTER THEY HAD BEEN USED FOR AN EVENT. MR. ROBINSON TOOK THE TABLES AND CHAIRS TO HIS RESIDENCE AT THE INCIDENT LOCATION TO DISINFECT THEM BEFORE RETURNING THEM TO MR. HILL.

DURING THE INCIDENT TIMES ON THIS REPORT, AN UNKNOWN OFFENDER TOOK ONE OF THE TABLES FROM THE BACK OF MR. ROBINSONS TRUCK WHILE SITTING AT THE INCIDENT LOCATION, UNOCCUPIED.

MR. ROBINSON STATED THAT HE HAS NOTIFIED MR. HILL OF THE INCIDENT AND THAT HE IS GOING TO GO TO LOWES AND PURCHASE ANOTHER TABLE TO REPLACE THE ONE THAT WAS STOLEN.

INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

ON 08/25/2020 I SPOKE WITH MS. MARILYN WATSON VIA TELEPHONE IN REFERENCE TO A SCAM.

MS. WATSON STATED THAT WHILE SHE WAS ON HER COMPUTER AT HER HOME ON 08/20/2020, A MESSAGE POPPED UP ADVISING THAT IT WAS FROM MICROSOFT AND THAT HER COMPUTER WAS NOT PROTECTED. A NUMBER WAS GIVEN FOR MS. WATSON TO CALL AND SET UP SECURITY ON HER COMPUTER.

MS. WATSON ALLOWED THE SUBJECTS TO GAIN ACCESS TO HER COMPUTER, CALLED THE NUMBER AND AFTER A FEW MINUTES OF CONVERSATION, AGREED TO PAY \$399.99 FOR 3 YEARS OF PROTECTION OF HER COMPUTER.

MS. WATSON INITIALLY TRIED TO PAY THE \$399.99 WITH HER CREDIT CARD BUT THE CREDIT CARD COMPANY DENIED THE PURCHASE. MS. WATSON THEN ASKED IF SHE COULD MAIL A CHECK FOR THE PAYMENT AND WAS ADVISED TO MAIL IT PRIORITY MAIL TO OLYMPIA SECURE LLC 4101 QUIET CROSSING COURT. FAIRFAX VA 220333 . MS. WATSON MAILED A PERSONAL CHECK IN THE AMOUNT OF \$499.99 TO THE ABOVE LISTED ADDRESS.

THE NEXT DAY MS. WATSON RECEIVED A TELEPHONE CALL FROM AN INDIVIDUAL WHO CLAIMED TO WORK AT THE FAIRFAX VA POST OFFICE AND ASKED IF THERE WAS A CHECK IN THE PRIORITY MAIL THAT SHE HAD SENT THEM. SHE ADVISED THAT THERE WAS.

MS. WATSON THEN BECAME SUSPICIOUS OF THE WHOLE SCENARIO AND CANCELED THE CHECK.

MS. WATSON STATED THAT SHE THEN CALLED THE POST OFFICE LOCALLY AND WAS ADVISED THAT THIS WAS PROBABLY A SCAM AND TO CONTACT LAW ENFORCEMENT.

MS. WATSON WAS ADVISED TO CONTACT HER BANKING INSTITUTION AND MAKE THEM AWARE OF THE INCIDENT AND POSSIBLY CHANGE HER BANKING ACCOUNT INFORMATION IN THE EVENT THAT THE OFFENDERS USE THE INFORMATION TO TAKE MONEY OUT OF HER ACCOUNT.

MS. WATSON WAS ADVISED THAT THIS REPORT WOULD BE ON FILE FOR DOCUMENTATION.

INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

ON AUGUST 25, 2020, I DEPUTY I. JOHNSON WAS DISPATCHED TO I-16 EAST AT MILE MARKER 132 IN REFERENCE TO VEHICLE DEBRIS IN THE ROADWAY.

UPON MY ARRIVAL, I MET WITH FOUR DRIVERS WHO STATED THEY WERE TRAVELING EAST ON I-16 IN THE FAST LANE WHEN A PIECE OF DEBRIS THAT CAME OFF A DUMP TRUCK TRAVELING IN THE SAME DIRECTION IN THE SLOW LANE. THE DUMP TRUCK (2004 STERLING TR LT) DRIVEN BY JOSEPH FLEMING, STATED THAT AS HE WAS TRAVELING EAST ON I-16 WHEN THE DRIVE SHAFT BROKE OFF HIS DUMP TRUCK IMPACTING FOUR VEHICLES UNDER CARRIAGES AND TIRES. THE FIRST VEHICLE (2015 DODGE DART) WHICH WAS DRIVEN BY MRS. BRITTANY BLAKE, DID NOT HAVE ANY VISIBLE DAMAGE BUT THEIR COULD POSSIBLE BE DAMAGE TO THE UNDER CARRIAGE OF THE VEHICLE, BECAUSE SHE STATED THAT SHE FELT THE DEBRIS GO UNDER HER CAR. THE SECOND VEHICLE (2012 TOYOTA CAMRY) WHICH WAS DRIVEN BY RALPH WALKER, EXPERIENCED A LEFT REAR FLAT TIRE AND UNKNOWN DAMAGE TO THE UNDER CARRIAGE OF THE CAR. MR. WALKER WAS ABLE TO CHANGE HIS TIRE AND WAS ABLE TO DRIVE HIS VEHICLE AWAY AFTERWARDS. THE THIRD VEHICLE (2020 KIA SEDONA) WHICH WAS DRIVEN BY MS. GAIL PANAYIS EXPERIENCED LEFT SIDE FRONT AND REAR FLAT TIRE DAMAGE. MS. PANAYIS WAS NOT ABLE TO DRIVE THE VEHICLE BECAUSE OF TWO FLAT TIRES AND UNKNOWN DAMAGE TO THE UNDER CARRIAGE OF THE CAR. SAPP WRECKER SERVICE FROM SAVANNAH, GEORGIA WAS CONTACTED AND TOWED THE VEHICLE. THE FOURTH VEHICLE (2016 TOYOTA RAV4 MP) WHICH WAS DRIVEN BY MS. PATRICIA BYRUM, EXPERIENCED A REAR LEFT SIDE FLAT TIRE. MS. BYRUM WAS ABLE TO ACCESS HER SPARE TIRE AND WAS ABLE TO DRIVE OFF AFTERWARDS.

EACH DRIVER WAS INFORMED THAT A REPORT WAS GOING TO BE FILE FOR INSURANCE PURPOSE. NO INJURIES WAS REPORTED AT THE TIME OF THIS INCIDENT.

MR. ANTONIO STATED THAT HIS AUNT RESIDES AT ONE OF THE ABOVE LISTED PROPERTIES. ON THE DATE OF THIS REPORT, MR. ANTONIO'S AUNT CONTACTED HIM AND STATED THAT SHE HAD RECEIVED A CALL FROM AN INDIVIDUAL WHO CLAIMED TO BE MR. JOSE ANTONIO AND DEMANDED THAT SHE MOVE OFF THE PROPERTY AND PROVIDE ALL LAND DOCUMENTS AND \$13,000.00.

MR. ANTONIO STATED THAT THE INDIVIDUAL ON THE PHONE KNEW HIS PERSONAL INFORMATION AND EVEN HIS PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT. MR. ANTONIO ALSO STATED THAT HE DOES NOT HAVE MANY FAMILY MEMBERS IN THE UNITED STATES AND THERE ARE NOT MANY PEOPLE WHO KNOW ABOUT HIS PERSONAL INFORMATION AND THE LAND INHERITANCE.

MR. ANTONIO HAS CONTACTED AUTHORITIES IN MEXICO BUT WAS ADVISED THAT THERE WAS NOTHING THEY COULD DO. THIS REPORT IS FOR DOCUMENTATION PURPOSES AT THIS TIME.
