INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

ON 08/25/2020 I SPOKE WITH MR. JOSE ANTONIO IN REFERENCE TO A SUSPICIOUS INCIDENT.

MR. ANTONIO STATED THAT HIS FATHER PASSED AWAY ON JULY 15TH, 2020 LEAVING HIM TO INHERIT OVER 150 ACRES OF LAND IN CHERANASTICO, MICHOCAN, MEXICO. THE LAND IS SEPARATED INTO DIFFERENT PLOTS. THREE OF THE PROPERTIES HAVE HOMES ON THEM.

MR. ANTONIO STATED THAT HIS AUNT RESIDES AT ONE OF THE ABOVE LISTED PROPERTIES. ON THE DATE OF THIS REPORT, MR. ANTONIO'S AUNT CONTACTED HIM AND STATED THAT SHE HAD RECEIVED A CALL FROM AN INDIVIDUAL WHO CLAIMED TO BE MR. JOSE ANTONIO AND DEMANDED THAT SHE MOVE OFF THE PROPERTY AND PROVIDE ALL LAND DOCUMENTS AND \$13,000.00.

MR. ANTONIO STATED THAT THE INDIVIDUAL ON THE PHONE KNEW HIS PERSONAL INFORMATION AND EVEN HIS PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT. MR. ANTONIO ALSO STATED THAT HE DOES NOT HAVE MANY FAMILY MEMBERS IN THE UNITED STATES AND THERE ARE NOT MANY PEOPLE WHO KNOW ABOUT HIS PERSONAL INFORMATION AND THE LAND INHERITANCE.

MR. ANTONIO HAS CONTACTED AUTHORITIES IN MEXICO BUT WAS ADVISED THAT THERE WAS NOTHING THEY COULD DO. THIS REPORT IS FOR DOCUMENTATION PURPOSES AT THIS TIME.

ON 08/26/2020 AT APPROXIMATELY 1751 HOURS I, DEPUTY BARRICK RESPONDED TO 2875 HIGHWAY 301 SOUTH THE PATRIOT INN IN REGARDS TO A DOMESTIC DISPUTE. UPON ARRIVAL I MET WITH SILVIA TAYLOR. TAYLOR STATED THAT HER BOYFRIEND JAMES WAS NOT SUPPOSED TO HAVE ANY CONTACT WITH TAYLOR OR HER SON PER HIS BOND CONDITION. TAYLOR STATED THAT SHE HAD NOT SEEN JAMES AT ALL TODAY, BUT JAMES WAS ON THE OTHER SIDE OF THE PATRIOT INN WITH HIS COUSIN TRYING TO HAVE TAYLOR COME AND SPEAK WITH HIM. TAYLOR THEN CALLED THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE. TAYLOR STATED THAT HE HAD ALREADY LEFT BEFORE WE GOT OUT THERE. I, DEPUTY BARRICK DETERMINED THAT THERE WAS NO SORT OF DOMESTIC. TAYLOR THEN STATED SHE KEPT GETTING THREATENING TEXTS AND PHONE CALLS FROM JAMES ABOUT HARMING TAYLOR AND HER SON. TAYLOR COULD NOT PROVIDE ANY SORT OF SCREENSHOTS WITH TEXTS OR PHONE CALLS. I, DEPUTY BARRICK DETERMINED THAT THIS WAS ONLY A HARASSING COMMUNICATIONS CALL. THIS REPORT IS FOR DOCUMENTATION.

INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

ON 08/27/2020, I, DEPUTY R. SHAFER WAS DISPATCHED TO 7613 STILSON-LEEFIELD ROAD IN REFERENCE TO A HARASSING COMMUNICATIONS INCIDENT. WHEN I ARRIVED I SPOKE TO THE COMPLAINANT MS. CHRISTINA MITCHELL. MS. MITCHELL ADVISED THAT, THE OFFENDER MR. CHARLES SWINT KEEPS HARASSING HER VIA PHONE, AND SHOWS UP AT HER RESIDENCE UNANNOUNCED.

BEFORE I ARRIVED ON SCENE MR. SWINT WAS AT MS. MITCHELL'S RESIDENCE BUT, WAS GONE ON ARRIVAL. MS. MITCHELL SPOKE TO MR. SWINT VIA PHONE WHILE I WAS THERE WITH HER, AND ADVISED MR. SWINT THAT SHE DID NOT WANT HIM ON HER PROPERTY. I TRIED TO SPEAK TO MR. SWINT VIA MS. MITCHELL'S PHONE, AND HE HUNG UP. I TRIED TO CALL MR. MITCHELL TO SERVE HIM WITH CRIMINAL TRESPASS FOR THE RESIDENCE OF 7613 STILSON-LEEFIELD ROAD, AND MR. SWINT WOULD NOT ANSWER.

MS. MITCHELL ADVISED THAT SHE WOULD GO GET A PROTECTIVE ORDER PLACED ON MR. SWINT ON 08/27/2020. I ADVISED MS. MITCHELL TO BLOCK WHATEVER NUMBERS SHE COULD OF HIS. I ADVISED MS. MITCHELL THAT THE REPORT WOULD BE DONE, AND THAT SHE COULD GET A COPY OF THE REPORT WITHIN THREE TO FIVE BUSINESS DAYS.
