ON 09/25/2020 I SPOKE WITH MS. APRIL ROBERTS VIA TELEPHONE IN REFERENCE TO A THEFT/CIVIL MATTER.

MS. ROBERTS STATED THAT ON OR ABOUT 08/25/2020 SHE HAD PERMISSION TO HAVE POSSESSION OF HER ESTRANGED HUSBAND'S AMERICAN EXPRESS CARD. DURING THAT TIME, MS. Ms. Thames also stated that she had been smoking marijuana and she just threw the "blunt" out of the window. While the probable cause search of the vehicle was being conducted there was also a silver round grinder in Ms. Thames purse with a green leafy substance inside of it. The "blunt" that Ms. Thames stated she threw out the window was located in between the passenger seat and the passenger door on the floor.
