**INCIDENT NARRATIVE:**

ON 09/22/2020 I SPOKE WITH MS. JOANNA AKINS VIA TELEPHONE IN REFERENCE TO IDENTITY FRAUD.

MS. AKINS STATED THAT WHILE RECENTLY CHECKING HER CREDIT REPORTS, SHE NOTICED THAT FIVE CREDIT ACCOUNTS DATED BACK TO 06/01/2019 HAD BEEN OPENED USING HER INFORMATION AND REPORTED TO THE CREDIT BUREAUS.

MS. AKINS STATED THAT THE FOLLOWING ACCOUNTS WERE FRAUDULENTLY OPENED:

1. JPMCB CARD ACCOUNT WITH A CREDIT LIMIT OF \$3000.00. INQUIRY DATE 09/19/2020
2. BANK OF AMERICA ACCOUNT WITH AN UNKNOWN CREDIT LIMIT. INQUIRE DAY 9/14/2020
3. JPMCB CARD ACCOUNT WITH A CREDIT LIMIT OF \$3000.00. INQUIRY DATE 08/12/2020
4. JPMCB CARD ACCOUNT WITH A CREDIT LIMIT OF \$8000.00. INQUIRY DATE 7/31/2020
5. PNC BANK CREDIT ACCOUNT WITH AN UNKNOWN CREDIT LIMIT. INQUIRY DATE 07/01/2019

ON 09/23/2020, I WAS ADVISED BY PORTAL MIDDLE HIGH SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION OF A STUDENT MAKING TERRORISTIC THREATS TOWARDS ANOTHER STUDENT.

AFTER FURTHER INVESTIGATION, THE JUVENILE OFFENDER WAS ARRESTED, SEARCHED, AND TRANSPORTED TO THE BULLOCH COUNTY JAIL FOR PROCESSING.

THE DEPARTMENT OF JUVENILE JUSTICE WAS CONTACTED.

A JUVENILE COMPLAINANT FORM WAS COMPLETED.

**INCIDENT NARRATIVE:**

ON 09/23/2020 AT APPROXIMATELY 1444 HOURS I MET WITH THE COMPLAINANT, PAMELA PIERCE, AT 1868 STARLING ROAD IN REFERENCE TO HARASSMENT. PIERCE STATED THAT HER SON, STEVEN PITTMAN, WAS CONTACTED BY HER EX-HUSBAND WILLIAM POWELL VIA FACEBOOK YESTERDAY AT APPROXIMATELY 1541 HOURS.

PIERCE SAID THAT PITTMAN TOLD HER, POWELL MESSAGED HIM AND TOLD HIM THAT "THEY" ISSUED A WARRANT FOR HIS MOTHER'S ARREST FOR NOT DOING WHAT SHE WAS ORDERED TO DO IN THEIR DIVORCE BY THE COURT. PITTMAN WAS NOT PRESENT AT THE TIME I MET WITH PIERCE, BUT PIERCE HAD A SCREEN SHOT OF THE CONVERSATION PITTMAN HAD WITH POWELL. PIERCE EXPLAINED THAT POWELL HAD BEEN CONVICTED OF RAPING HER AND WAS SENTENCED TO JAIL IN 2012, THE SAME YEAR THEY WERE DIVORCED. PIERCE STATED THAT SHE COMPLIED WITH ALL ORDERS OF THE COURT THAT DAY IN 2012, AND INTERPRETED THIS MESSAGE FROM POWELL TO HER SON AS HARASSMENT TOWARDS HER. PIERCE SAID THAT SHE HAD PREVIOUSLY HAD A TPO AGAINST POWELL AFTER HER DIVORCE, BUT WAS RECENTLY TOLD BY THE CLERK OF COURTS THAT IT WAS ONLY VALID FOR 1 YEAR.

PIERCE STATED THAT SHE IS AFRAID OF POWELL AND FEARED THAT HE WOULD TRY TO HARM HER AGAIN. PIERCE WAS ADVISED BY THE CLERK OF COURTS TO FILE A REPORT WITH THE BULLOCH COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE ABOUT THIS HARASSMENT TO OBTAIN A TPO AGAIN.

I RAN PIERCE'S INFORMATION INTO GCIC AND THERE IS NOT ACTIVE WARRANT FOR HER ARREST. I ADVISED PIERCE THAT WITH HER HISTORY OF ABUSE FROM POWELL THAT SHE MAY BE ABLE TO OBTAIN ANOTHER TPO FOR THAT ALONE. I DID TELL PIERCE THAT POWELL CONTACTED HER SON ONLY ONCE AND THOUGH THE STATEMENT WAS UNTRUE ABOUT THE WARRANT, HE HAD MADE NO THREAT OF BODILY HARM, AND HAD NOT REPEATEDLY CONTACTED HER OR HER SON TO FIT THE CODE SECTION OF HARASSING COMMUNICATIONS (OCGA 16-11-39.1).

I PULLED A CASE NUMBER FOR HARASSMENT. I TOOK PHOTOGRAPHS OF THE COMPLAINT FOR DIVORCE, AND THE MESSAGE SENT FROM POWELL TO PITTMAN AND ATTACHED THEM TO THE CASE FILE. I GAVE PIERCE THE PHONE NUMBER TO SAFE HAVE AND TOLD HER TO CONTACT THEIR REPRESENTATIVE IN REGARDS TO OBTAINING A TPO.

THIS CASE IS CURRENTLY INACTIVE.

ON THE ABOVE DATE AND TIME, I RESPONDED TO A CALL IN THE LOBBY OF THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE IN REFERENCE TO AN ENTERING AUTO. I MET WITH THE COMPLAINANT WHO STATED HE HAD HIS FIREARM STOLEN OUT OF HIS VEHICLE. HE STATED HE BELIEVES IT HAPPENED BETWEEN THE ABOVE DATES. HE WAS UNSURE OF EXACTLY WHERE IT MAY HAVE HAPPENED.

THE COMPLAINANT ADVISED HE BELIEVES THE FIREARM WAS EITHER TAKEN FROM HIS VEHICLE AT HIS RESIDENCE OR AT HIS GIRLFRIEND'S RESIDENCE OFF OF PEG WEN BLVD IN THE CITY OF STATESBORO. HE BELIEVES THAT HIS TRUCK MAY HAVE BEEN UNLOCKED DUE TO THERE BEING NO FORCED ENTRY ON HIS VEHICLE. THE COMPLAINANT ALSO ADVISED THERE WERE NO OTHER ITEMS TAKEN FROM THE VEHICLE.

THE COMPLAINANT WAS ABLE TO GIVE ME THE SERIAL NUMBER OFF OF THE FIREARM. THE FIREARM INFORMATION WAS GIVEN TO DISPATCH TO BE ENTERED INTO GCIC AS STOLEN. REPORT TURNED OVER TO CID. THE FIREARM IS DESCRIBED AS A GLOCK 22 .40 CALIBER HANDGUN, BLACK IN COLOR.
