**INCIDENT NARRATIVE:**

ON 09/07/2020, I, DEPUTY R. SHAHER WAS DISPATCHED TO 9651 US-301 S AT THE CHEVRON, IN REFERENCE TO A SUSPICIOUS INCIDENT. WHEN I ARRIVED I SPOKE TO THE COMPLAINANT MRS. AMANDA CARD. MRS. CARD ADVISED THAT WHILE SHE WAS WORKING, A YOUNGER BLACK FEMALE CAME INTO THE STORE, APPROXIMATELY AROUND 1352 HOURS TO BUY SOME CIGARETTES. WHEN MRS. CARD ASKED FOR THE FEMALE'S ID, THE FEMALE TOLD HER SHE DID NOT HAVE IT.

MRS. CARD ADVISED THAT, THE FEMALE WALKED OUT OF THE STORE AND CAME BACK INSIDE WITH AN OLDER BLACK MALE. THE BLACK MALE FLASHED A SILVER BADGE, AND DEMANDED THAT MRS. CARD SELL THE CIGARETTES TO HIS DAUGHTER.

MRS. CARD ADVISED THAT SHE IS ON PROBATION, AND WAS SCARED THAT SHE WOULD GET IN TROUBLE, AND GO BACK TO JAIL IF SHE DID NOT. MRS. CARD ADVISED THAT SHE SOLD THE CIGARETTES TO THE FEMALE AND MALE, AND THAT THEY LEFT THE STORE AND WENT SOUTH TOWARD CLAXTON ON 301 SOUTH. MRS. CARD ADVISED THAT BOTH SUBJECTS DROVE AWAY IN WHAT APPEARS TO BE A DODGE RAM 1500 PICKUP, BLUE IN COLOR.

MRS. CARD SENT ME PICTURES VIA TEXT MESSAGE. THE PICTURES SHOW AN ELDERLY BLACK MALE, WEARING A HAT, GREY SHIRT, AND BAGGY PANTS FLASH A SILVER BADGE AT MRS. CARD. AS WELL AS IN THE SURVEILLANCE VIDEO, THE VIDEO HAS NO AUDIO.
