ON 09/17/2020 I SPOKE WITH MS. GEORGIANA DARSEY VIA TELEPHONE IN REFERENCE TO IDENTITY FRAUD.

MS. DARSEY STATED THAT ON 08/26/2020 SHE RECEIVED A LETTER TO THE INCIDENT LOCATION ON THIS REPORT ADDRESSED TO HER. THE LETTER WAS FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INSIDE CONTAINED A FORM FOR MS. DARSEY TO FILL OUT REGARDING UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE BENEFITS. THE FORM ALSO LISTED MS. DARSEY'S PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT AND SALARY.

MS. DARSEY STATED THAT SHE HAS NOT APPLIED FOR ANY TYPE OF ASSISTANCE THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR. SHE HAS ALSO CONSULTED WITH THE HUMAN RESOURCE DEPARTMENT AT HER PLACE OF UNEMPLOYMENT AND WAS ADVISED THAT THEY DID NOT FILE ANY THING ON HER BEHALF.

MS. DARSEY HAS CONTACTED THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND WAS ADVISED TO FILE AN INCIDENT REPORT WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT AND PROVIDE THEM WITH A COPY FOR THEIR INTERNAL INVESTIGATION. IT IS BELIEVED THAT AN UNKNOWN OFFENDER USED MS. DARSEY'S INFORMATION TO TRY AND OBTAIN MONIES ILLEGALLY.

INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

ON SEPTEMBER 17, 2020 I DEPUTY I. JOHNSON MET WITH COMPLAINANT MRS. ANNA WILLIAMS WHO STATED THAT SHE WANTED MR. DAVID CANNON SERVED A CRIMINAL TRESPASS WARNING FOR HER RESIDENCE.

MS. WILLIAMS STATED THAT SHE PAID MR. DAVID CANNON \$1500 DOLLARS TO FENCE IN HER BACKYARD AND THAT HE WAS TAKING LONGER THAN THE COMPLETION DATE. MS. WILLIAMS STATED THAT MR. CANNON STARTED ON THE FENCE ON SEPTEMBER 7, 2020 AND WAS SUPPOSED TO BE DONE SEPTEMBER 11, 2020. MS. WILLIAMS STATED THAT EVERY TIME SHE CALLS MR. CANNON HE EITHER DOESN'T ANSWER THE PHONE OR HE GIVES HER THE RUN AROUND ABOUT WHY IT'S TAKEN LONGER THAN EXPECT. MS. WILLIAMS STATED THAT MR. CANNON LEFT SOME EQUIPMENT AT HER RESIDENCE AND THAT SHE WASN'T GOING TO RETURN IT TO HIM BECAUSE SHE FELT LIKE IT WAS EQUAL TO HOW MUCH WORK WAS LEFT TO COMPLETE THE FENCE. I INFORMED MRS. WILLIAMS THAT SHE CAN'T HOLD MR. CANNONS EQUIPMENT HOSTAGE THAT SHE NEEDS TO ALLOW HIM TO RECOVER IT.

UPON MY DEPARTURE, I CALLED MR. CANNON AND DIDNT GET AN ANSWER. A FEW HOURS LATER MR. CANNON'S SON JOSHUA CANNON CALLED ME BACK AND STATED TO ME THAT HIS FATHER DIDN'T HEAR THE PHONE RINGING. I INFORMED MR. CANNON'S SON WHO WAS AWARE OF WHAT GOING ON BETWEEN THE TWO PARTIES THAT HIS FATHER WAS NOT ALLOW TO COME TO MRS. WILLIAMS RESIDENCE ANYMORE AND THAT SHE WANTS TO SERVE MR. DAVID CANNON WITH A CRIMINAL TRESPASS WARNING. MR. CANNON SON INFORMED ME THAT HIS FATHER HAS ALREADY MADE IT CLEAR WITH MRS. WILLIAMS THAT HE WAS DONE DOING ANY WORK FOR HER ANYMORE AND THAT HE WOULD NOT BE RETURNING TO HER RESIDENCE. I INFORMED MR. CANNON THAT MS. WILLIAMS ADVISED ME THAT HE STILL HAD TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT AT HER RESIDENCE. HE STATED HE DID NOT KNOW THEY STILL HAD EQUIPMENT THERE BUT HE WOULD SPEAK TO HIS FATHER IN THE MORNING WHEN HE GOT UP. I COULD NOT SPEAK TO MR. DAVID CANNON AT THE TIME OF THIS CALL DUE TO HIM ALREADY ASLEEP. I WILL TRY TO MAKE CONTACT WITH HIM AT A LATER DATE AND SERVE HIM A CRIMINAL TRESPASS WARNING FOR MS. WILLIAMS RESIDENCE. MRS. WILLIAMS WAS ADVISED OF THE MAGISTRATE COURT PROCESS.
