INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

ON 08/31/2020 I SPOKE WITH MR. JAMONE RAYMOND AT THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE IN REFERENCE TO TERRORIST THREATS.

MR. RAYMOND STATED THAT HIS COUSIN, KEITH SPELLS, HAS BEEN MAKING THREATS TOWARD HIM VERBALLY AND VIA TELEPHONE. MR. RAYMOND STATED THAT MR. SPELLS SOMETIMES RESIDES AT THE NEIGHBORING HOUSE TO HIS AND COMES ONTO HIS PROPERTY TO CAUSE TROUBLE.

MR. RAYMOND STATED THAT ON 08/31/2020 MR. SPELLS CAME TO HIS RESIDENCE AND PLACED SEVERAL ARTICLES OF CLOTHING IN HIS SHOP. MR. RAYMOND ASKED MR. SPELLS NOT TO PUT CLOTHES ON HIS PROPERTY. MR. SPELLS THEN BEGAN TO TELL MR. RAYMOND THAT HE WAS GOING TO PUNCH HIM IN THE NOSE AND BEAT HIM AND HIS CHILDREN. MR. SPELLS ALSO SENT MR. RAYMOND A TEXT MESSAGE WITH A PHOTO OF A FIREARM AND CAPTIONED IT "IM GOING TO TAKE OUT A RESTRAINING ORDER ON YOU".

MR. RAYMOND STATED THAT HE HAS ALREADY SPOKEN WITH THE MAGISTRATE COURT ABOUT OBTAINING A PRIVATE WARRANT ON MR. SPELLS. THIS REPORT IS DOCUMENTATION FOR MR. RAYMOND TO POSSIBLY PURSUE THAT ACTION.

MR. RAYMOND ALSO ADVISED THAT HE WANTED MR. SPELLS SERVED WITH CRIMINAL TRESPASS FOR THE PROPERTY AT THE INCIDENT LOCATION ON THIS REPORT. I ATTEMPTED TO MAKE CONTACT WITH MR. SPELLS VIA TELEPHONE BUT MY ATTEMPTS WERE UNSUCCESSFUL AT THIS TIME.

INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

On 08-31-2020 I was dispatched to 30759 West Highway 80 for a suspicious incident.

Upon my arrival, I spoke with Mr. Freddie Richardson Senior and Junior. They stated that they were driving to Valdosta when Mr. Joshua Richardson reached over from the passenger seat and put the vehicle in park while they were moving. They both stated Mr. Joshua then told them to get out of the vehicle and he got in the driver seat and drove off leaving them on the side of West Highway 80. Other deputies were attempting to locate the vehicle. They located the vehicle at West Highway 80 and the Bypass. When the other deputies attempted to stop Mr. Joshua he fled from them. I then had Mr. Freddie Richardson Senior and Junior get into my patrol car and I was going to transport them to the Bulloch County Sheriff's Office. While en route to the Sheriff's Office the deputies got Mr. Joshua to stop fleeing at East Northside Drive and Lee Street. I then rerouted to that location so the victims could get there vehicle.

When I arrived at East Northside Drive and Lee Street Bulloch County Deputies and Statesboro Police Department Officer's were struggling to get Mr. Joshua into the back of a patrol car. I assisted getting Mr. Joshua into the patrol car by going into the patrol car from the opposite side and getting Mr. Joshua's arm and helped pulling him back into the car. When we got Mr. Joshua into the patrol car we all then followed to the jail to assist if needed because jail staff was limited. Mr. Freddie Richardson Senior and Junior then drove there vehicle to the Sheriff's Office so we could get more information.

When we arrived at the jail Mr. Joshua was then refusing to get out of the patrol car. Mr. Joshua eventually got out and was placed in the restraint chair. Mr. Joshua was booked into the Bulloch County Jail on the above listed charges. Nothing further.

INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

ON THE ABOVE DATE AND TIME, I RESPONDED TO A CALL IN REFERENCE TO AN UNRULY JUVENILE. THE COMPLAINANT CALLED AND STATED HER CHILD WAS ATTEMPTING TO BURN THE RESIDENCE DOWN AND WAS ARMED WITH A KNIFE IN THE BACKYARD. UPON MY ARRIVAL, I SPOKE WITH THE COMPLAINANT WHO STATED HER SON HAD LOCKED HIMSELF IN HIS ROOM. I WAS ABLE TO CONVINCE THE JUVENILE TO EXIT HIS ROOM AND SPEAK WITH US.

WHEN I SPOKE WITH THE JUVENILE I ASKED HIM WHY HE ATTEMPTED TO CAUSE A FIRE WHERE HE STATED HE WAS LIGHTING A CIGARETTE WITH AN ELECTRICAL OUTLET. HE THEN STATED THAT HE BECAME UPSET AND MADE CUTS ON HIS ARM WITH A STEAK KNIFE BECAUSE PAIN MAKES HIM FEEL BETTER. HE STATED HE WAS MAD BECAUSE DFACS WAS COMING TO GET HIM TOMORROW.

HIS MOTHER STATED IT WAS JUST HER AND HER SON AT THE RESIDENCE AT THE TIME OF THE INCIDENT. SHE STATED SHE NOTICED THERE WAS A LOT OF SMOKE IN THE RESIDENCE AND SHE THEN CALLED HER HUSBAND TO COME HOME. SHE THEN CONFRONTED HER SON ON WHAT HAPPENED AND HE TOLD HER HE WAS LIGHTING A CIGARETTE WITH AN ELECTRICAL OUTLET. THE MOTHER THEN TOLD HIM TO GO TO HIS ROOM WHERE HE THEN CALLED HER A NAME AND WENT TO HIS ROOM. BOTH PARENTS STATED AFTER GOING TO HIS ROOM, HE CAME OUT AND HAD A KNIFE AND HE WALKED OUTSIDE. THEY STATED THEY CALLED FOR HIM BUT DID NOT GET AN ANSWER BUT THEN HEARD A LOUD NOISE FROM HIM HITTING THE BRICK ON THE SIDE OF THE HOUSE. HE THEN CAME BACK IN THE RESIDENCE AND WENT TO HIS ROOM AND LOCKED THE DOOR.

WHILE SPEAKING WITH THE JUVENILE, I NOTICED HIS ARM HE HAD SMALL CUTS ON HIS RIGHT ARM. HE ADMITTED THAT HE DID THIS WITH THE KNIFE. I THEN EXPLAINED TO HIM THAT HE WAS GOING TO HAVE TO GO TO THE HOSPITAL. HE STATED HE WAS NOT GOING TO THE HOSPITAL. I ADVISED HIM THAT HE HAD NO CHOICE. WE THEN BEGAN TO GRAB HIM TO GET HIM TO GO TO THE HOSPITAL WHERE HE TENSED UP BUT DID NOT FULLY RESIST. HIS PARENTS FOLLOWED US TO THE HOSPITAL.

WE ALSO SPOKE TO DJJ DUE TO DEALING WITH THE JUVENILE MULTIPLE TIMES. THEY ADVISED THAT IF HE WAS CHARGED WITH A MISDEMEANOR THAT THEY WOULD NOT DETAIN HIM DUE TO HIS MENTAL HEALTH ISSUES. I THEN WAS ABLE TO ARRIVE AT THE HOSPITAL WHERE THE JUVENILE WAS THEN TURNED OVER TO THEM AND HIS PARENTS. REPORT FOR DOCUMENTATION.
