INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

ON THE ABOVE DATE AND TIME, I RESPONDED TO A CALL IN REFERENCE TO A SUSPICIOUS INCIDENT. I MET WITH THE COMPLAINANT WHO INFORMED ME HE RECENTLY HAD SOMEONE KNOCK ON HIS FRONT DOOR WHERE HE ANSWERED AND NO ONE WAS THERE. HE STATED HE THEN HEARD A KNOCK AT THE BACK DOOR WHERE HE ANSWERED AND ONCE AGAIN NO ONE WAS THERE, HE THEN STATED HE NOTICED HIS PORCH LIGHTS BEGAN TO TURN OFF AND HE NOTICED THE LIGHTS HAD BEEN UNSCREWED.

I THEN ASKED THE COMPLAINANT IF HE WAS MISSING ANY ITEMS FROM HIS FRONT PORCH WHERE HE STATED HE WAS NOT. THEN I ASKED WERE HIS VEHICLE LOCKED AND IF THEY HAD ANYTHING MISSING. HE INFORMED HIS VEHICLE WAS UNLOCKED BUT HIS GIRLFRIEND'S WAS LOCKED. HE STATED HE NOTICED SOME ITEMS WERE MOVED FROM HIS CENTER CONSOLE AND PLACED IN THE PASSENGER SEAT BUT NO ITEMS WERE ACTUALLY TAKEN.

DUE TO THERE BEING POTENTIAL FOR A STRING OF THEFTS TO BE HAPPENING, WE CALLED FOR THE TRACKING K9 TO ASSIST WITH THE SCENE. THE NEIGHBORS NEXT DOOR STATED THEY SAW A WHITE MALE WITH A PLAID SHIRT AND A BLACK MALE IN DARK CLOTHES IN THE AREA BUT WERE WALKING TOWARD A TRAIL. THE K9 WAS DEPLOYED BUT AFTER A BRIEF WHILE A SCENT TRAIL COULD NOT BE PICKED UP ON A POTENTIAL OFFENDER.

THE COMPLAINANT AND NEIGHBORS WERE ADVISED TO INFORM THE REST OF THE NEIGHBORHOOD TO MAKE SURE THEY WEREN'T MISSING ANYTHING AND TO ALSO LOCK UP THEIR BELONGINGS.

INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

ON 10/27/2020 I SPOKE WITH MR. MELVIN ETHRIDGE VIA TELEPHONE IN REFERENCE TO A STOLEN TRAILER HITCH WITH BALL.

MR. ETHRIDGE STATED THAT HE LAST SAW HIS 6" DROP TRAILER HITCH WITH A 2" INCH BALL AFFIXED TO HIS VEHICLE AT THE INCIDENT LOCATION ON THIS REPORT. MR. ETHRIDGE ALSO STATED THAT THE HITCH WAS LOCKED TO HIS VEHICLE BY A PIN LOCK THAT HE HAS THE KEY TO.

MR. ETHRIDGE DOES NOT BELIEVE THE HITCH FELL OFF THE VEHICLE HOWEVER, THERE IS NO DAMAGE TO HIS VEHICLE. MR. ETHRIDGE WANTED THIS INCIDENT CONDUCTED FOR DOCUMENTATION PURPOSES.

MR. ETHRIDGE STATED THAT HE HAS THOROUGHLY OBSERVED ALL OF HIS PROPERTY AND NOTHING ELSE APPEARS TO BE MISSING AT THIS TIME.

INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

ON 10/27/2020, I, DEPUTY R. SHAFER WAS DISPATCHED TO 625 BLACK CREEK CHURCH ROAD, IN REFERENCE TO A DAMAGE TO PROPERTY INCIDENT THAT HAD ALREADY OCCURRED. WHEN I ARRIVED I SPOKE TO THE COMPLAINANT MS. NICOLE SAPP. MS. SAPP ADVISED THAT HER AND MR. JOHN TAYLOR WAS AT ON THE GO FOOD MART AT SR-67 AT HIGHWAY 46, AND THAT SHE WENT INSIDE THE STORE AND WHEN SHE CAME BACK OUT THE WINDSHIELD WAS BUSTED. MS. SAPP ADVISED THAT MR. TAYLOR ADMITTED TO IT IN THE TEXT THAT HE HAD SENT HER BUT, WHEN I READ THE TEXT I SAW NO EVIDENCE THAT HE ADMITTED TO DOING IT OR MALICIOUS INTENT FOR DOING IT. MR. TAYLOR ADVISED MS. SAPP IN THE TEXT THAT HE WAS MAD ABOUT HIS CHARGER AND DID NOT THROW THE WATCH AND THAT IT WENT BETWEEN THE SEATS AND WHEN HE SNATCHED IT THE WATCH ENDED UP ON THE DASH.

I ASKED MS. SAPP IF SHE SEEN MR. TAYLOR THROW THE WATCH AND CRACK THE WINDSHIELD. MS. SAPP ADVISED THAT SHE DID NOT SEE IT. MS. SAPP ADVISED THAT HER MOTHER MS. STACIA FARRIS WANTED TO PRESS CHARGES. I ADVISED MS. SAPP THAT DUE TO NOT BEING ABLE TO DETERMINE WHETHER MR. TAYLOR MALICIOUSLY BROKE THE WINDSHIELD OR ACTUALLY DONE IT, I WOULD DO A REPORT FOR DOCUMENTATION AND WOULD REFER HER AND HER MOTHER TO MAGISTRATE COURT OVER THE MATTER.

MS. SAPP THEN ASKED ABOUT MR. TAYLOR COMING BACK TO HER RESIDENCE. I ASKED MS. SAPP IF MR. TAYLOR HAD RESIDENCY AT HER RESIDENCE. MS. SAPP ADVISED THAT MR. TAYLOR DID. I ADVISED MS. SAPP IF SHE FELT UNSAFE OR THE NEED TO GET MR. TAYLOR OUT OF HER RESIDENCE THAT SHE WOULD HAVE TO GO TO MAGISTRATE AS WELL TO HAVE MR. TAYLOR EVICTED. MS. SAPP ASKED ABOUT IF MR. TAYLOR COMES HOME AND BECOMES AGGRESSIVE. I ADVISED MS. SAPP THAT IF MR. TAYLOR COMES BACK TO THE RESIDENCE AND TRIES TO CAUSE PROBLEMS, TO CALL THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND WE WOULD COME OUT THERE.
