On 10/13/2020 at approximately 0028 hours, I was stationary in the median of Highway 67, facing southbound, just north of Mud Rd. I was operating speed detection radar. I observed a silver Nissan Maxima traveling northbound on Highway 67 at a high rate of speed. My front radar indicated the vehicle was traveling at 80 miles per hour. The vehicle decreased speed to 78 miles per hour as it approached me. I conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle. The vehicle also returned through GCIC/NCIC with expired registration as of 10/3/2020. The driver, Kimberly Griffin, was issued a citation for the expired registration in lieu of a speeding citation. She was released on a copy of the charge.

INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

ON THE ABOVE DATE AND TIME, I RESPONDED TO A CALL IN REFERENCE TO SOMEONE BEING ON THE PROPERTY THAT WAS NOT WANTED. I MET WITH THE COMPLAINANT WHO ADVISED THE OFFENDER DID NOT LIKE HIM AND HAD THREATENED HIM IN THE PAST. ON THE NIGHT OF THE INCIDENT THE COMPLAINANT STATED THE OFFENDER PULLED INTO THE DRIVEWAY AND GOT OUT OF HIS VEHICLE AND ATTEMPTED TO INTIMIDATE HIM. THE COMPLAINANT STATED HE THEN ACTED LIKE HE WAS CALLING SOMEONE AND THE OFFENDER SOON LEFT THE RESIDENCE. THE COMPLAINANT ALSO SUSPECTS THAT THE OFFENDER HAS BEEN STEALING HIS MAIL AS WELL.

I SPOKE WITH THE OWNER OF PROPERTY WHO IS THE SISTER OF THE OFFENDER AND SHE STATED THEY ALL HAVE BEEN HAVING PROBLEMS WITH HIM. SINCE IT WAS HER MOTHER'S PROPERTY SHE HAS BECOME THE NEW OWNER OF THE PROPERTY AND THE COMPLAINANT HAS BEEN RENTING FROM HER. I ASKED IF IT WOULD BE ALRIGHT IF I SERVED THE OFFENDER WITH A CRIMINAL TRESPASS WARNING AND SHE STATED YES IT WAS. I ATTEMPTED TO CALL THE OFFENDER ON SCENE WHERE HE DID NOT ANSWER.

SOME TIME LATER, THE OFFENDER CALLED ME BACK. I SPOKE WITH HIM IN REFERENCE TO THE SITUATION AND HE STATED HE WAS NOT AT THE INCIDENT LOCATION TONIGHT. HE STATED HE WAS TALKING WITH LAWYERS AND PLANNED TO GO TO COURT TO OBTAIN THE PROPERTY SINCE IT WAS NOT HIS. HE STATED HE WAS UPSET WITH THE COMPLAINANT OVER ANOTHER ISSUE BUT THAT WAS THE EXTENT OF THEIR PROBLEMS.
