INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

ON THE LISTED DATE AND TIME, I RESPONDED TO THE LISTED LOCATION IN REFERENCE TO A DISPUTE BETWEEN ISADOR GONZALEZ, KANISHA STEPHENSON, AND KENO HOLT. UPON MY ARRIVAL, I MADE CONTACT WITH HOLT. HOLT STATED THAT HE AND STEPHENSON JUST BROKE UP AND SHE WAS AT THEIR RESIDENCE GATHERING HER BELONGINGS. HOLT STATED THAT WHILE SHE WAS GETTING HER THINGS, SHE PUT HIS COUCH OUTSIDE AND DESTROYED THE INSIDE OF THE HOUSE. HOLT ALSO STATED THAT SHE DAMAGED HIS WASHER AND WIFI BOX. I DID NOTICE THE HOUSE TO BE IN DISARRAY AND THE WASHER HAD SOME MARKS ON IT. HOLT STATED THAT THERE WAS NO PHYSICAL CONTACT, JUST VERBAL.

I THEN SPOKE WITH GONZALEZ AND STEPHENSON. STEPHENSON STATED THAT HE WAS AT THE RESIDENCE TRYING TO GET HER BELONGING AND THAT SHE BROUGHT GONZALEZ WITH HER TO HELP. STEPHENSON STATED THAT WHEN HOLT ARRIVED ON SCENE THERE WAS A VERBAL ALTERCATION AND LED TO HOLT STRIKING GONZALEZ WITH A TIRE IRON. I DID NOTICE A SMALL CUT AND A SMALL BRUISE ON GONZALEZ RIGHT SIDE ARM.

ALL PARTIES WERE ADVISED OF REMEDIES. GONZALEZ WAS REFERRED TO MAGISTRATE COURT TO PURSUE CRIMINAL CHARGES IF HE WISHES. A REPORT WAS TAKEN.

On 10/12/2020 at approximately 2255 hours, I was stationary in the median of Highway 67 north of Mud Rd facing southbound. I was operating speed detection radar. I observed a white Jeep Grand Cherokee approaching from behind me, southbound on Highway 67 at a high rate of speed. My rear radar indicated the vehicle was traveling at 81 miles per hour. The speed limit on that portion of Highway 67 is 55 miles per hour. The vehicle was the only vehicle in the radar beam. I conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle. The driver, Heather Williams, stated she is not from the area and did not know the speed limit. When asked, Heather declined a secondary accuracy check on the radar. She was issued a citation for speeding 81 mph in a 55 mph zone. She was released on a copy of the charge.

INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

On 10/12/2020 at approximately 2340 hours, I was stationary, facing southbound, in the median of Highway 67 north of Mud Rd operating speed detection radar. I observed a red Chevrolet Malibu traveling northbound on Highway 67 at a high rate of speed. The vehicle entered my front radar beam at 76 miles per hour. As the vehicle approached me, it increased speed to 78 miles per hour. The vehicle was the only vehicle in the radar beam. The speed limit on that portion of Highway 67 is 55 miles per hour. I conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle. Upon meeting with the driver, Dyquan Capers, he requested a secondary accuracy check of the radar. This was conducted at 2350 hours. Dyquan also returned through GCIC/NCIC with a suspended driver's license for "safety responsibility". There was no serve date on the suspension. Dyquan was notified of the suspension and called for someone to retrieve him and his vehicle. He was issued a citation for speeding 78 miles per hour in a 55 mile per hour zone. INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

ON THE ABOVE DATE AND TIME, I RESPONDED TO A CALL IN REFERENCE TO SOMEONE BEING ON THE PROPERTY THAT WAS NOT WANTED. I MET WITH THE COMPLAINANT WHO ADVISED THE OFFENDER DID NOT LIKE HIM AND HAD THREATENED HIM IN THE PAST. ON THE NIGHT OF THE INCIDENT THE COMPLAINANT STATED THE OFFENDER PULLED INTO THE DRIVEWAY AND GOT OUT OF HIS VEHICLE AND ATTEMPTED TO INTIMIDATE HIM. THE COMPLAINANT STATED HE THEN ACTED LIKE HE WAS CALLING SOMEONE AND THE OFFENDER SOON LEFT THE RESIDENCE. THE COMPLAINANT ALSO SUSPECTS THAT THE OFFENDER HAS BEEN STEALING HIS MAIL AS WELL.

I SPOKE WITH THE OWNER OF PROPERTY WHO IS THE SISTER OF THE OFFENDER AND SHE STATED THEY ALL HAVE BEEN HAVING PROBLEMS WITH HIM. SINCE IT WAS HER MOTHER'S PROPERTY SHE HAS BECOME THE NEW OWNER OF THE PROPERTY AND THE COMPLAINANT HAS BEEN RENTING FROM HER. I ASKED IF IT WOULD BE ALRIGHT IF I SERVED THE OFFENDER WITH A CRIMINAL TRESPASS WARNING AND SHE STATED YES IT WAS. I ATTEMPTED TO CALL THE OFFENDER ON SCENE WHERE HE DID NOT ANSWER.

SOME TIME LATER, THE OFFENDER CALLED ME BACK. I SPOKE WITH HIM IN REFERENCE TO THE SITUATION AND HE STATED HE WAS NOT AT THE INCIDENT LOCATION TONIGHT. HE STATED HE WAS TALKING WITH LAWYERS AND PLANNED TO GO TO COURT TO OBTAIN THE PROPERTY SINCE IT WAS NOT HIS. HE STATED HE WAS UPSET WITH THE COMPLAINANT OVER ANOTHER ISSUE BUT THAT WAS THE EXTENT OF THEIR PROBLEMS. I THEN ADVISED HIM I WAS SERVING HIM WITH A CRIMINAL TRESPASS WARNING FOR THE INCIDENT LOCATION AND EXPLAINED TO HIM WHAT IT WAS. HE STATED HE UNDERSTOOD AND WOULD NOT COME BACK. ON 10-13-20 AT APPROXIMATELY 1126 HRS I WAS TRAVELING EAST BOUND ON HIGHWAY 80 EAST JUST WEST OF ARCOLA RD. I WAS IN A LINE OF APPROXIMATELY 8 CARS WHEN I NOTICED A VEHICLE IN MY REAR VIEW MIRROR THAT WAS ALSO TRAVELING EAST BOUND IN THE WEST BOUND LANE PASSING ALL OF US AT A HIGH RATE OF SPEED. THE VEHICLE WAS A 2018 WHITE IN COLOR CHEVROLET SILVERADO. THE DRIVER OF THE SILVERADO PASSED MYSELF AND OTHER VEHICLES BEHIND ME AND ALSO PASSED APPROXIMATELY 4 VEHICLES THAT WERE IN FRONT OF ME. THIS AREA THAT HE WAS PASSING IN IS A NO PASSING ZONE AND HE GOT BACK OVER INTO THE EAST BOUND LANE JUST PAST ARCOLA RD. I TURNED ON MY BLUE LIGHTS AND SIREN AND INITIATED A TRAFFIC STOP ON THE VEHICLE EAST OF ARCOLA RD ON HIGHWAY 80. THE TRUCK HAD A GEORGIA TAG OF CLF 2980. I MADE CONTACT WITH THE DRIVER (WILLIAM TROY DEESE) AND GOT HIS LICENSE AND HE KNEW WHY HE WAS BEING PULLED OVER.
