Dasher was purchasing the listed vehicle for his brothers birthday. Mr. K. Boyd stated Mr. D. Dasher was going to have a friend of his show up to pick up the listed vehicle after the transaction was completed. Mr. K. Boyd state he asked Mr. D. Dasher for a copy Mr. D. Dasher's drivers license and Credit Card used in the transaction. Mr. K. Boyd stated Mr. D. Dasher for a \$300.00 charge that occurred while using a Credit Card.

I attached several times to contact Mr. D. Dasher as well as Clif in regards to this matter.

I spoke with Investigator Reid Odom as well as Investigator Walter Deal with the Bulloch County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigation Division in regards to this matter. It was determined a crime was committed against Clif being the victim and Mr. D. Dasher being the offender for Identity Fraud O.C.G.A. 16-9-121(4). It was also determined that Mr. D. Dasher would be charged with Financial Transaction Card Fraud O.C.G.A. 16-9-33(2)(c), if the listed victim can provide to the Bulloch County Sheriff's Office a copy of the \$300.00 charge against them due to there credit card career.

This investigation is still ongoing and turned over to the Criminal Investigation Division.
