INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

A TRAFFIC STOP WAS CONDUCTED ON A 2014 NISSAN ALTIMA AFTER THE VEHICLE WAS CHECKED AT 93 MILES PER HOUR ON VETERANS MEMORIAL PARKWAY BETWEEN JONES MILL ROAD AND STATE ROUTE 24, THE VEHICLE WAS TRAVELING WEST. I WAS PATROLLING, TRAVELING EAST ON THE BYPASS, AND HAD TO DRIVE THROUGH THE MEDIAN BETWEEN THE LANES OF TRAVEL. I SAW THE SPEEDING VEHICLE APPLY THE BRAKES, BUT DID NOT ATTEMPT TO PULL OVER. THE VEHICLE TURNED RIGHT ONTO STATE ROUTE 24, I OVERTOOK THE VEHICLE AS IT TURNED INTO MILL CREEK LANDING APARTMENTS. CONTACT WAS MADE WITH THE DRIVER, IDENTIFIED AS DEVON MARKESE THOMPSON BY HIS VALID GEORGIA DRIVERS LICENSE. MR. THOMPSON EXPLAINED TO ME THAT HE WAS TRYING TO SLOW DOWN BUT HIS FLIP-FLOP WAS STUCK ON THE ACCELERATOR. A LADY CAME TO THE VEHICLE, STATING THAT SHE WAS HIS MOTHER, AND THAT HE WAS IN A HURRY TO GET TO HER TO TAKE HER TO AN APPOINTMENT.
