ON THE ABOVE DATE AND TIME, I RESPONDED TO A CALL IN REFERENCE TO A THEFT. UPON MY ARRIVAL, I MET WITH THE COMPLAINANT WHO INFORMED ME THEY HAD BEEN DOING WORK TO THE RESIDENCE SO THAT THEY COULD MOVE IN SOON. SHE STATED THAT WHEN SHE RETURNED TO THE RESIDENCE TODAY TO CONTINUE WORKING, SHE BEGAN TO NOTICE SOME ITEMS WERE MISSING.

SHE STATED THAT SHE LEFT THE RESIDENCE THE DAY PRIOR AROUND 1830 AND THAT ALL THE TAKEN ITEMS WERE THERE. SHE STATED SHE WAS UNAWARE OF WHOM MIGHT'VE TAKEN THEM. SHE STATED THAT ONE OF THE MOVERS KEPT ASKING TO PRESSURE WASH THE HOUSE AND STATED HE WANTED TO START HIS OWN PRESSURE WASHING BUSINESS. On October 3, 2020 at approximately 1127 hours I, Corporal Juarez, spoke with Ayanna Brack via phone regarding an identity theft report. Ayanna reported that in July of 2020, she needed to apply for unemployment because she was no longer working. Ayanna didn't know how to apply for unemployment so she asked her cousin, Amberelle Jones, to assist her in the matter. Amberelle informed Ayanna that she needed personal information such as her social security number and other personal documents. Ayanna stated that she trusted Amberelle with this information because they are cousins so she provided it to her.

After applying for unemployment, Ayanna waited several months to receive certain information to see if she was approved. After a long period of time, she decided to call the unemployment office and they advised that in their system it showed that Ayanna was already receiving funds, and they observed that the funds were being spent. Ayanna requested the information, but the service representative could not provide the information for security purposes. However, the representative did inform her that the funds were being used by her to make online purchases, and they were being sent to different addresses. The representative also informed Ayanna that the amount spent was a total of nearly \$16,000.

According to Ayanna, she states that she has never seen any funds in any accounts, and she was never informed that she was ever approved for unemployment. Furthermore, Ayanna states that she suspects that her cousin, Amberelle, may have used her identity, or may have lost the identify that she provided and someone else could be using it. At this time Amberelle is a suspect, the offender is unknown. The case has been turned over to the Criminal Investigation's Division.

I SPOKE WITH MS. WATERS ABOUT THE SITUATION. MS. WATERS ADVISED THAT THEY GOT IN AN ARGUMENT OVER MR. CONGER LYING TO HER. I ASKED MS. WATERS HOW MR. CONGER GOT THE MARKS ON HIS FACE AND NECK. MS. WATERS ADVISED THAT SHE DID NOT TOUCH HIM. MS. WATERS THEN ADVISED THAT IT MAY OF HAPPENED WHEN MR. CONGER PUSHED HER AND SHE GRABBED ONTO HIM TO CATCH HER FALL AND SHE MAY HAVE SCRATCHED HIM.
