INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

DEPUTIES RESPONDED TO THE STORE AT COUNTRY CLUB AND VETERANS MEMORIAL PARKWAY IN REFERENCE TO A UNWANTED BLACK MALE. ARRIVING I SPOKE WITH THE CLERK WHO STATED THAT THE MALE HAD LEFT DRIVING IN A GREY CAR WITH EXTENSIVE DAMAGE TO THE FRONT. SHE CONTINUED TO EXPLAIN THAT HER NIGHT SHIFT CLERK HAD ALLOWED THE UNKNOWN MALE TO STAY AT THE STORE LAST NIGHT. SHE ESTIMATES THAT THE UNKNOWN MALE HAD STAYED AT THE STORE FOR ABOUT 15 HOURS.

DEPUTIES SEARCHED THE AREA WITHOUT CONTACT UNTIL A CITIZEN NOTIFIED DEPUTY B. KINGREY ABOUT A SILVER/GREY CAR PARKED ON PULASKI HIGHWAY. DEPUTY KINGREY MADE CONTACT WITH THE VEHICLE, STOPPED, PARKED IN THE MIDDLE OF THE ROAD RUNNING. THERE WAS NO ONE AROUND THE VEHICLE. K-9 WAS REQUESTED TO ATTEMPT TO DETERMINE A DIRECTION OF TRAVEL. BEFORE K-9 4 ARRIVED, A CALL WAS RECEIVED OF A MALE AT 1544 WESTSIDE ROAD, ACTING STRANGELY. THE MALE WAS SAID TO BE A LIGHT SKIN BLACK MALE AND WAS NAKED. DEPUTIES RESPONDED TO THE INCIDENT QUICKLY AND IT WAS DETERMINED THAT THIS WAS THE SAME MALE FROM THE CAR, AND STORE. HE WAS IDENTIFIED AS MAKILI AISAIAH-D' SHON MATHIS. THE VEHICLE WAS TOWED BY LIST WRECKER, STATESBORO TIRE AND BRAKE RESPONDED. VEHICLE IMPOUND AND INVENTORY WAS COMPLETED.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL PERSONNEL WAS NOTIFIED FOR MR. MATHIS. HE WAS NAKED, WITH OPEN SCRATCH'S, AND ALSO CUTS ON HIS FEET. HE WAS TRANSPORTED TO THE HOSPITAL, E.M.T.'S GAVE HIM A SHEET TO WEAR. AT EAST GEORGIA REGIONAL MEDICAL CENTER, IT WAS LEARNED THAT MR. MATHIS WAS IN THE FACILITY ON FRIDAY, AN WAS 10-13, ON FRIDAY. MR. MATHIS WAS REMANDED TO THE HOSPITAL MEDICAL STAFF.

ON 10/06/2020 I SPOKE WITH MS. HELEN HARDEN AT THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE IN REFERENCE TO IDENTITY FRAUD.

MS. HARDEN STATED THAT SHE RECENTLY LOGGED ON TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR WEBSITE TO INQUIRE ABOUT UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS. UPON ENTERING HER INFORMATION (SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER, ETC.) SHE WAS MADE AWARE THAT AN ACCOUNT WAS ACTIVE IN HER NAME AND HAD BEEN SINCE APPROXIMATELY THE FIRST OF JULY, 2020.

MS. HARDEN STATED THAT AN UNKNOWN OFFENDER HAS BEEN RECEIVING UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS USING HER INFORMATION (SHE COULD NOT PROVIDE THE AMOUNT). MS. HARDEN HAS MADE SEVERAL ATTEMPTS TO CONTACT THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INFORM THEM OF THE FRAUDULENT ACTIVITY BUT HAD NOT BEEN ABLE TO CONTACT ANYONE. MS. HARDEN HAS NOT RECEIVED ANYTHING IN THE MAIL FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND IS UNSURE WHAT ADDRESS WAS USED BY THE OFFENDER(S).

On 10-07-2020 I conducted a traffic stop after running a license plate through GCIC and the registered owner of the vehicle's license was suspended. The traffic stop was conducted at Pojos on Highway 301 South.

When I approached the vehicle, the driver was the registered owner Mr. Immanuel Lawton. When I asked Mr. Lawton for his drivers license, Mr. Lawton stated that he did not have his License on him. I asked Mr. Lawton for his name and date of birth, Mr. Lawton gave me a name of Daryl Scott DOB 10-03-1989. When I ran the name through GCIC there was no OLN on file for that name and date of birth. I noticed the picture on GCIC for the registered owner was the same person in the driver seat. After pulling Mr. Lawton out of the vehicle, I asked him what his real name was and he told me it was Immanuel Lawton.

I could smell the odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle. Mr. Lawton stated, he had just smoked marijuana in the car at his residence approximately 30 minutes prior to the traffic stop. I conducted a probable cause search of the vehicle and no marijuana was located in the vehicle.

Mr. Lawton was issued two citations for driving while license suspended and giving false name and DOB. Ms. Talease Oglesby picked Mr. Lawton up from the scene. Nothing further.
