I asked Mr. Lawton for his name and date of birth, Mr. Lawton gave me a name of Daryl Scott DOB 10-03-1989. When I ran the name through GCIC there was no OLN on file for that name and date of birth. I noticed the picture on GCIC for the registered owner was the same person in the driver seat. After pulling Mr. Lawton out of the vehicle, I asked him what his real name was and he told me it was Immanuel Lawton.

I could smell the odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle. Mr. Lawton stated, he had just smoked marijuana in the car at his residence approximately 30 minutes prior to the traffic stop. I conducted a probable cause search of the vehicle and no marijuana was located in the vehicle.

Mr. Lawton was issued two citations for driving while license suspended and giving false name and DOB. Ms. Talease Oglesby picked Mr. Lawton up from the scene. Nothing further.
