INCIDENT NARRATIVE:

A TRAFFIC STOP WAS COMPLETED AFTER I CHECKED A VEHICLE SPEEDING AT 90 MILES PER HOUR IN A 65 MILE PER HOUR ZONE ON U.S. 25 AT THE INTERSECTION OF PONDEROSA ROAD. THE SPEEDING VEHICLE WAS TRAVELING SOUTH ON 25, I WAS PATROLLING NORTH. THE TAG WAS ENTERED INTO THE G.C.I.C. BEFORE MAKING CONTACT WITH THE DRIVER, AND IT WAS DISCOVERED THAT THE TAG WAS EXPIRED, EXPIRED IN APRIL, 2020. CONTACT WAS MADE WITH THE DRIVER, IDENTIFIED AS ARTESHA KAMIA NEWTON BY HER VALID GEORGIA DRIVERS LICENSE.
