ON THE ABOVE DATE AND TIME, I RESPONDED TO A CALL IN REFERENCE TO A DOMESTIC DISPUTE. UPON MY ARRIVAL, I SPOKE WITH THE VICTIM WHO STATED SHE AND HER SOON TO BE EX HUSBAND HAD GOTTEN INTO AN ALTERCATION AFTER HE CAME OVER TO SEE HER. SHE STATED HE WAS INTOXICATED AND SHE NO LONGER WANTED HIM AT THE RESIDENCE AND HE DID NOT WANT TO LEAVE, AFTER SEVERAL ATTEMPTS TO GET HIM TO LEAVE SHE CALLED LAW ENFORCEMENT.

BY THE TIME I ARRIVED THE OFFENDER HAD ALREADY LEFT THE SCENE. SHE STATED HE POSSIBLY LEFT AND HEADED TO HIS EX WIFE'S RESIDENCE OFF OF DEALWOOD DRIVE.
