MR. WARREN WAS LATER PROVIDED A BILL OF SALE BY MS. GLISSON. SINCE THE DATE OF PURCHASE, MR. WARREN HAS NOT RECEIVED THE TITLE TO THE VEHICLE AS PROMISED. HE HAS MADE SEVERAL ATTEMPTS TO CONTACT MR. BOLTON AND MS. GLISSON AND WAS ADVISED BY MR. WARREN THAT MS. GLISSON HAD MOVED TO NORTH CAROLINA.

MR. WARREN WAS ADVISED BY THE TAG OFFICE ON THE PROCEDURES OF OBTAINING A TITLE FOR THE VEHICLE. HE WAS ALSO ADVISED TO FILE A REPORT WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT TO FURTHER PURSUE CIVIL CHARGES.
