Chairman Sparks called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. and led the Moment of Silence and Pledge of Allegiance.

The Bulloch County Foundation for Public School Education presented the following teachers with a check for being awarded a fall innovation mini grant. Michael Mascolo, Hanna Turner, Marchelle Russell, Patia Rountree received two grants, Allison Bailey, Concella Holder, Tammy Davis, Amy Smith, Katherine Wellman, and Valerie Morris

Re: September 2021 Financial Reports

Highlights for the General Fund revenues and expenditures are as follows:

- Property Tax bills have been sent out by the Tax Commissioner's office and payments to them are due on December 1st. We have begun to see an increase in these payments to us from the Tax Commissioner's office and this will peak in December and then taper off in January until next fall. It is too early to speculate on our final collections.
- Local Option Sales Tax (LOST) Continues to come in strong and above the amount budgeted. During this first quarter, we collected approximately 10% more than what we collected for the same time period last year.
- State QBE revenues are being collected as they were budgeted.
- Expenditures in the General Fund were in line as they were budgeted. As of September 30, 2021, we have completed 25.0% of the fiscal year and our year-to-date expenditures are at 23.4% of total budget.
