A RESOLUTION

Supporting the people of Ukraine during the crisis caused by the invasion of Ukraine by the Russian Federation; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, on or about February 24, 2022, the Russian Federation began an unprovoked invasion of Ukraine, an independent and sovereign nation; and

WHEREAS, the people of Ukraine continue to suffer obvious, demonstrable, and irreparable harm; and

WHEREAS, the United States of America and all divisions within remain allies of Ukraine and the people of Ukraine; and

WHEREAS, this invasion's impact on energy prices has confirmed again that the United States must reduce or eliminate its reliance on foreign energy sources and must institute a policy of energy independence; and

WHEREAS, the State of Georgia has proven that a diverse mix of energy sources maintains dependable energy production and, ultimately, keeps prices low for ratepayers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GEORGIA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION that the undersigned members of this body condemn the invasion of Ukraine by the Russian Federation and call on Russia to end its unprovoked aggression.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the undersigned call on their Federal Government, in an effort to continue the United States' support of Ukraine while minimizing detrimental financial impact on its poorer residents, to partner with individual State Public Service Commissions to unshackle America's natural resources.


