Overview of the 2023-2024 Georgia Milestones Public Release



Summary of 2023-2024 Results

- Georgia students continued to show overall improvement on the Georgia Milestones assessments following the COVID-19 pandemic.
 - Results increased or held steady on 10 of 13 assessments in ELA, science, and social studies.
 - Mathematics results are not yet available due to the implementation of new math content standards and assessments.
- The results show that steady academic recovery is continuing in Georgia's public schools.



Continued Investments in Academic Recovery: A trained literacy coach in every struggling elementary school...



- Part of Georgia's tiered and tailored statewide coaching model and partnership with School Improvement
- 60 literacy coaches placed in elementary schools across the state
- Focused on the lowest-performing 5 percent of schools
- Trained in the science of reading
 - Led by our Structured Literacy Coaching Coordinator (headed literacy coaching efforts for Marietta City Schools)



Continued Investments in Academic Recovery

Launched in 2023-2024

- GaTutor Program Working with 100 Georgia teachers to provide online, one-on-one tutoring sessions for high school students in EOC courses.
- AmeriCorps Tutoring Program Partnering with AmeriCorps Math Corps and Reading Corps programs to provide tutoring for up to 5,000 students.

Additional Supports for 2024-2025

- Expanding BEACON formative assessments to Grades K-2.
- Focusing on literacy beyond just K-3; Launching birth to 12th grade approach.
